

Ship *Hibernia* Laying a Jar Port

Saturday Sept 9th Pleasant with a heavy swell engaged in boiling and stowing down finished stowing at 6 AM latter part pleasant boiling and cruising for whales

Sunday Sept 10th Pleasant Boats off cruising for whales latter part weather the same drove the oil and sent all ashore that wanted to go latter part most of the crew on shore

Monday Sept 11th Pleasant most of the crew on shore latter part commenced stowing down the oil no Boats off but the Capt and he went ashore blowing strong

Tuesday Sept 12th Blowing very heavy engaged in stowing down oil latter part a heavy gale from the Westward dragged the anchor and had to let go the other and gave her sixty fathoms chain latter part rather more moderate engaged in stowing down and clearing up deck

Wednesday Sept 13th Pleasant weather all hands engaged in scraping bone latter part a strong breeze two Boats looking for whales

Thursday 14th Pleasant and a strong breeze Boats off whaling and the rest scraping bone and clearing up decks

Friday Sept 15th Pleasant with a strong breeze from the N^W two Boats off looking for whales and the rest of the crew a scraping bone latter part the same

Saturday Sept 16th Pleasant with a strong breeze Boats off looking for whales then on board scraping bone latter part the same

Chotsk Sea Whaling

Sunday Sept 17th Strong breeze and pleasant weather Boats off looking for whales and the rest scraping bone latter part all hands on board making a bone pen and stowing the bone away the Capt got on board of the Ship George Howland of New Bedford

Monday Sept 18th Rather more pleasant nothing doing and all heeled on board the Capt on board of the Howland fire latter part pleasant unbet the Main Topsail and mended it two Boats off looking for whales

Tuesday Sept 19th Pleasant with light breeze mending the main topsail latter part bent it and unbet the foretopail and mended it latter part all hands on board humming ship and mending sail

Wednesday 20th Blowing strong from the N^W all hands mending sail latter part more pleasant with snow squalls all hands engaged in mending sails

Thursday Sept 21st Commenced with squally weather and a fine breeze saw several whales but did not lower all hands engaged in mending sails latter part all Boats off looking for whales saw three

Friday Sept 22nd Pleasant Boats off looking for whales but see none latter part pleasant at 4 PM got under way and saw other vessel got under way all bound to the S^E

Saturday Sept 23rd Pleasant all sail set steering S^W and mending the Main sail and bent it saw no whales latter part pleasant steering S^E as a course with light air from the S^W
