*Saturday* Oct 14<sup>th</sup> Pleasant with a strong breeze ship makes the best of her way to the Eastward latter pleasant with a strong breeze course East & took in the Mast and New Boats Lat 47° 09

*Sunday* Oct 15<sup>th</sup> Light winds and pleasant weather course E by Sth all sail set neither seen watches engaged in various duties latter part pleasant with light air and calm course E by Sth nothing seen

*Monday* Oct 16<sup>th</sup> Pleasant with light air and calm course East by Sth latter part pleasant with a strong breeze watches engaged in various duties saw porpoises Lat 46° 03 Nth

*Tuesday* Oct 17<sup>th</sup> Commences with fine weather and a strong breeze from the S Wth course East by Sth watches engaged in various duties latter part fine weather and a strong breeze from the S W course E by Sth watches engaged in washing their clothes

*Wednesday* Oct 18<sup>th</sup> Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the Westward course East by Sth nothing seen watches engaged in washing their clothes latter part pleasant with a strong breeze course East by Sth Lat 44. 18 Nth

*Thursday* Oct 19<sup>th</sup> Pleasant with a fine breeze from the Westward course East by Sth saw porpoises and finbacks watches engaged in various duties latter part fine weather and a fine breeze from the Westward ship heading to the Eastward on the water saw porpoises and finbacks *Mis Ship* making a fly jill *Brown* Lat 43° 31 Nth

*Friday* Oct 20<sup>th</sup>

Commences with pleasant weather and a good breeze from the Nth East ship on the wind heading S by East at 4 of the put Don Castillo in *Jerns* for using a knife on the Boy Peter, and put him on the run it appears that he has used a knife on this boy before cutting him on the knee and this time cut his head he is very troublesome anyway latter part a gale from the Nth East ship here too under close reefed main topsail and staysails No Cls

*Saturday* Oct 21<sup>st</sup>

Commences with a gale from the Nth East ship laying too under close reefed main topsail and staysails took the *Jerns* off of Don Castillo and let him go forward latter part a heavy gale from the Nth East ship here too under close reefed main topsail and staysails watches engaged in washing off the ship aft

*Sunday* Oct 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with plenty of fog and rain and a fine breeze from the S Wth course with a heavy swell ship under double reefed topsails and courses latter part pleasant with a strong breeze from the Eastward ship heading various courses Lat 40° 03 Nth Long 119° 30 East

*Monday* Oct 23<sup>rd</sup>

Pleasant with a strong breeze from the Nth course East ship under double reefed topsails and courses pumped ship and found her to leak a little latter part foggy with a fine breeze from the Nth course East No Cls to day

*Tuesday* Oct 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with foggy weather and a fine breeze from the Nth course East latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from S W course No Cls
