Friday Oct 27th

Commences with thick rainy weather with a fine breeze from N<sup>W</sup> East ship on the wind heading to the E<sup>S</sup>E on the wind latter part foggy with rain and a fine breeze from the N<sup>W</sup> East ship heading to the S<sup>W</sup> East on the wind the leak about the same I went down in the fore peak and after hold to see if I could find the leak but could not find it Lat 35<sup>o</sup> 17' N<sup>th</sup>

Saturday Oct 28th

Commences with fine weather and a fine breeze from the S<sup>W</sup> course East latter part squally with a strong breeze from the S<sup>W</sup> course East all 100 set Lat 34<sup>o</sup> 44' N<sup>th</sup> Long 164<sup>o</sup> 11'
