

Ship Hibernia a Halekaho Bay Sandwich

Tuesday Nov 10th Commences with fine weather and a light breeze all hands engaged in various duties middle part rainy latter part fine weather got off some fruit and hogs and Potatoes and cleared ship outside the Ship Liverpool of New Bedford laying here from the Arctic with nothing at all

Saturday Nov 11th Commences with fine weather engaged in painting ship and various other duties latter part pleasant sent the Starboard Watch on liberty the watch on board painting ship the Liverpool sailed for Honolulu

Sunday Nov 12th Pleasant weather engaged in painting ship latter part the Starboard Watch on liberty

Monday Nov 13th Pleasant weather nothing doing latter part pleasant the Starboard Watch on liberty the watch on board painting ship

Tuesday Nov 14th Commences with pleasant weather the Starboard Watch on liberty the watch on board engaged in various duties the Ship Tigee of Stonington came in here today from the Ochotsk Sea with 1000 lbs of Seal blubber latter part pleasant sent one Boat off after trade all hands on board painting ship

Wednesday Nov 15th Pleasant all hands on board painting ship one Boat off trading latter part pleasant the Starboard Watch on liberty

Thursday Nov 16th Pleasant the Starboard watch on liberty the watch on board getting off Potatoes and finishing painting latter part the same

Friday Nov 17th Pleasant weather and variable winds getting off Potatoes and other things a Schooner came in to night latter part the Starboard Watch on liberty

Saturday Nov 18th Pleasant weather and nothing doing latter part weather the same got off some pumpkins the Starboard Watch on liberty

Sunday Nov 19th Pleasant weather and nothing doing latter part the same the Starboard Watch ashore on liberty

Monday Nov 20th Commences with pleasant weather and light air latter part fine weather and light air at 3 P.M. called all hands and hove up the anchor and got under way stowed the chairs and washed off decks

Tuesday Nov 21st Commences with pleasant weather and light baffling air standing out towards Proves latter part light air and calms nothing doing but looking out for the ship

Wednesday Nov 22nd Commences with light air and calms at 6 A.M. took the trades and took in the fly jib and topgallant sails course Nth by West latter part pleasant with light baffling wind and calms engaged in setting up the rigging

Thursday Nov 23rd Commences with pleasant weather and light baffling wind saw six sails and the Island of Oahu bearing N 77 W 40 miles distant latter part pleasant at 8 P.M. took a Pilot and at 10 came to an anchor in the harbor of Oahu in 5 fathoms water and made port
