

Ship *Hebernia* at Oahu

Tuesday Nov 24th Pleasant with light air and calms filled fifteen casks with salt water to bring her down by the stern but no go it only tipped her three inches latter part pleasant got the ship on the mud and commenced breaking out the fore hok to light the bow all the crew refused to do duty

Saturday Nov 25th Pleasant engaged in lighting the Ship's bow latter part all hands that we shipped in teleahuanu refused to do duty and went ashore on their own hook

Sunday Nov 26th Commenced with pleasant weather what few men we have on board engaged in breaking out the fore hok latter part pleasant all hands

Monday Nov 27th Pleasant nothing doing latter part finished breaking out the fore feet and got a stage alongside to work on the bow the coffee off along ways below the edge of the Water Wm Freeman Wm Wilmington and George Paulin and Thompson turned to duty and the Spaniards all have been ashore fifty hours and not one of them has been near the ship since last Saturday Morning 9 o'clock and it is now noon so I took what things belong to me and that is not much

Tuesday Nov 28th Pleasant the carpenters to work on the bow not much doing David Parcel went ashore at 3 o'clock latter part broke out the Bone and dried it and commenced bundling and marking it

Wednesday 29th Pleasant weather engaged in bundling Bone and capping the bow and putting on some sheathing latter part took 60 bundles of Bone on board of the King noble David Parcel has not made his appearance yet weight of Bone 6466 lbs

Sandwich Islands 1853

Thursday Nov 30th Pleasant finished the Bow at sunset and David Parcel still ashore making fifty one hours since he left the ship latter part engaged in getting ready to haul the ship off of the mud

Friday Dec 1st Pleasant weather got all ready to haul the ship got a fall fast to another ship and have all we could but could not start her one peg for we had no tide in today latter part pleasant hauled the ship out of the mud and dropped the anchor under foot

Saturday Dec 2nd Pleasant stowing down latter part moved the ship and finished stowing down and secured up decks

Sunday Dec 3rd Pleasant cleared up decks and got the water casks ready to get off Water latter part took in a raft of casks and filled it and got it off again and hoisted it in on deck

Monday Dec 4th Pleasant stowed down the water that we got off this morning and cleared up decks Smith has not been seen since 7 o'clock this morning latter part nothing doing

Tuesday Dec 5th Pleasant pumped ship some ashore to check latter part pleasant nothing doing

Wednesday Dec 6th Pleasant got off Potatoes and stowed them away latter part cleared up decks

Thursday Dec 7th Pleasant not much doing latter part painted the Bows and cleared up decks latter part nothing doing got off Potatoes

Friday Dec 8th Pleasant nothing doing latter part the same

Saturday Dec 9th Pleasant weather and nothing doing latter part pleasant heading and Sugen latter part pleasant nothing doing latter part six men men run away and left nothing behind them John Richardson Brown Joseph John Boy and Cartwright
