Monday Dec 11th Pleas got ~~the~~ more men yet latter part got off seven men and got the ship out side.

Tuesday Dec 12th Got off some of the crew and sent the other men ashore latter part got off some more of the crew the ship laying off and on.

Wednesday Dec 13th Pleasant engaged in stowing the anchors and clearing up decks latter part pleasant engaged in various duties.

Thursday Dec 14th Pleasant with light baffling air ship laying off and on at 2 P.M. a boat brought off John and Joe both duties engaged in coaling lines and getting the boats ready for whaling latter part pleasant engaged in sorting over Potatoes.

Friday Dec 15th Commences with pleasant weather and light baffling winds ship laying off and on not much doing latter part pleasant ship heating up off Cape.

Saturday Dec 16th Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. at 2 P.M. parted the weather fly jib & gaff and then made a new one and sent it out latter part pleasant with light airs and baffling wind.

Sunday Dec 17th Commences with fine weather with the wind from the N.W. ship beating up for Cape engaged in ships duties latter part pleasant at 8 P.M. Capt came on board and we stood away to Sea.

Monday Dec 18th Pleasant with light airs and calm ship heading to the Eastward latter part pleasant nothing doing but getting ready for whaling.

Tuesday Dec 19th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the Eastward ship heading to the N.E. latter part wind and weather the same saw finbacks.

Wednesday Dec 20th Pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the Eastward ship heading to the N.E. latter part strong breeze from the E.S.E. ship heading to the N.E.

Thursday Dec 21 Commences with squally weather and strong breezes ship heading N.E. as a course latter part rather more moderate.

Friday Dec 22nd Strong breeze from the E.S.E. course N.E. at sunset shortened sail latter part squally with a strong breeze from the Eastward wore new fabrics and main buntlines.

Saturday Dec 23rd Commences with light baffling wind latter part light airs and calm saw one finback.

Sunday Dec 24th Commences with light airs and calm latter part strong breezes and squally weather.

Monday Dec 25th Commences with strong breezes from the N.E. ship heading to the N.W. on the wind latter part pleasant nothing doing.

Tuesday Dec 26th Commences with pleasant weather and a good breeze from the N.E. ship heading to the N.W. on the wind latter part wind and weather the same.
