

Ship Hikunua laying in Mangarua Bay getting the

Wednesday February 14th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the Westward two Boats ashore cutting wood those on board mending sails and getting the Ship up latter part pleasant stood up the Bay till the tide turned then let go the Anchor again

Thursday February 15th Pleasant two Boats ashore cutting wood those on board engaged in various duties latter part pleasant got the Ship up to the head of Navigation and let go the Anchor

Friday February 16th Pleasant two Boats ashore cutting wood three men run away sold a Main Sled to the Capt of the Magall of New London he got a Whale to day latter part Larboard Boat struck and killed and anchored

Saturday 17th Pleasant shared with two Boats the other two Boats towed the Whale to the Ship and the line parted and we anchored him till the next tide

Sunday February 18th Pleasant got the Whale to the Ship and made port the Starboard Boat struck and drove latter part cut in the Whale and all hands on board cutting him up

Monday February 19th Pleasant all hands on board cutting up the Whale and boiling him latter part sent three Boats off after whales latter part the Waist Boat struck and the Waist and Larboard Boats got stove

Tuesday February 20th Pleasant got the Whale to the Ship and made him part

Wednesday 21st Pleasant cut in the Whale all hands on board cutting up the Whale and clearing up decks

Thursday February 22nd Pleasant all hands on board latter part sent three Boats off to get a Whale if they could latter part pleasant boats off but got no whale

Friday February 23rd Pleasant weather not much doing but whaling latter part Boats off chasing the Larboard Boat struck a calf but it had no Mother so we killed it the other two Boats chasing

Saturday February 24th Pleasant the Waist Boat struck and we killed and anchored him latter part towed the Whale to the Ship and got Dinner Larboard Boat stove and the Bow Boat cracked

Sunday February 25th Pleasant cut in the Whale and started the works latter part boiling today the Ship Magall got a Whale in a Bay where there was only three foot water on the line the cut him on the Beach and towed the Blubber to the Ship latter part pleasant chased whales without success

Monday February 26th Pleasant engaged in boiling latter part shared Whales without success the Larboard Boat struck and we lay by him till the tide turned

Tuesday February 27th towed the Whale to the Ship and cut him in started the works and finished Ship got ready to stow down oil latter part boiling and stowing down and chasing whales

Wednesday February 28th Stowing down oil and boiling done without success latter part pleasant finished boiling

Thursday March 1st Pleasant chasing whales without success latter part the Starboard Boat struck the Capt got his Boat stove
