

Friday March 2nd Towed the whale to the Ship and cut him in and commenced boiling latter part finished boiling and went after another whale without success

Saturday March 3rd Boats off after whales without success latter part the same caught a Deer

Sunday March 4th Boats off after whales the Starboard Boat struck a calf and the Iron Deer latter part a strong Breeze latter part ~~was~~ Boats off all hands that was on board engaged in stowing down oil

Monday March 5th Pleasant all hands on board engaged in stowing down cask and Beef latter part engaged in breaking out the after hole to this ship and getting off wood

Tuesday March 6th All hands engaged in cutting and stowing wood latter part three Boats off after a whale the rest engaged in getting off wood and cutting more ~~latter~~ struck one whale and killed him forty miles from the Ship so we left him

Wednesday March 7th Boats got on board at 1/2 past 11th latter part went up the other side but see nothing there on board engaged in clearing up and stowing wood

Thursday March 8th Sent three Boats off after a whale if they could find one latter the same getting off Wood and clearing Whales

Friday March 9th Three Boats off after Whales latter part getting off wood and clearing up

Saturday March 10th Pleasant weather engaged in cutting Wood and getting it off and clearing up the Ship latter part cutting and getting off Wood

Sunday March 11th Pleasant engaged in cutting and getting off Wood latter part a strong breeze and nothing doing

Monday March 12th Pleasant with a strong breeze nothing doing latter part getting off Wood and getting ready to leave here

Tuesday March 13th Pleasant with a very strong breeze nothing doing latter part got under way and stood down the river latter part got off sand twelve barrels ~~gave~~

Wednesday March 14th Pleasant engaged in various duties got some towline from the Ship Berg Morgan of New London and some Boat chails and Cars latter part got under way and stood out to Sea stowed the Anchors and Chains

Thursday March 15th Pleasant engaged in various duties saw one Devil Fish latter part a strong breeze double reefed the topsails and furl the Mainmast

Friday March 16th Pleasant with a strong breeze from the N^W ship on different tacks saw two but no Spum Whales latter part pleasant with a strong breeze ship under short sail saw two Ships supposed to be the Berg Morgan and Bengall

Saturday March 17th Pleasant with a strong breeze from the N^W ship on different tacks nothing seen not much doing ~~IKP~~ and had some for supper latter part fine weather and a light breeze from the Westward ship on different tacks saw a Barge bound to the Leeward engaged in clearing ship

Sunday March 18th Pleasant with light breezes from various quarters nothing doing latter part pleasant saw fourbacks
