

Thursday April 17th Blowing a gale but we finished cutting the Whale and secured away the Case and Tank and started the works the Whale was blasted considerable latter part weather the same engaged in boiling

Friday April 20th Pleasant with a strong breeze engaged in boiling latter part weather the same finished boiling the Capt and Cook had some woods and both got cut

Saturday April 21st Pleasant engaged in various duties latter part pleasant engaged in various duties

Sunday April 22nd Pleasant engaged in various duties nothing seen latter part pleasant nothing doing

Monday April 23 Pleasant saw finbacks nothing doing latter part thick weather raised Spinn Whales breaching engaged in mending the Starboard Boat

Tuesday April 24th Thick hazy weather lowered for Whales but the weather was so thick that we lost the run of them latter part a strong breeze finished mending the Boat nothing seen

Wednesday April 25th A strong breeze and rugged weather at sunset raised a School of small Whales, lowered the three Boats and the Bow and Waist Boats struck and took their Whales to the Ship the Starboard Boat struck two or three times and drove latter part a strong breeze called all hands at daylight and out in the Whales and commenced clearing away the Heads

Thursday April 26th Pleasant with a strong breeze engaged in clearing up the decks and started the work latter part pleasant engaged in boiling saw finbacks

Friday April 27th Pleasant finished boiling saw finbacks latter part a strong breeze all hands engaged in stowing down oil nothing seen

Saturday April 28th Pleasant weather all hands stowing down oil finished stowing down and washed off decks latter part pleasant with a fine breeze engaged in breaking out Water casks to repair nothing seen

Sunday April 29th Pleasant at 4 past twelve raised small Spinn Whales lowered the Boats for them they going quick to the windward the Starboard Boat struck and got him alongside and made fast for the night latter part looked on to the Whale and cut him at 9 P.M. raised Spinn Whales going quick to the windward lowered and chased without success

Monday April 30th Pleasant cleared away the head and started the works saw two sails bent to the Head latter part a strong breeze built up the topsails

Tuesday May 1st Pleasant engaged in boiling finished at 2 P.M. and cleared up decks saw one finback latter part pleasant with a strong breeze engaged in stowing down

Wednesday May 2nd Pleasant engaged in stowing down latter part pleasant engaged in various duties

Thursday May 3rd Pleasant engaged in various duties saw finbacks latter part engaged in stowing down oil at 8 P.M. raised a school of Spinn Whales to the windward it blowing a gale at the time so that we could not get the Ship there so we did not lower for them
