boat struck a small one and got foul of another
Whale the Harbour Boat struck the Whale that
his line was foul of and the Waist Boat struck
the calf the others went off chased till we lost
the run of them all together then came on board
and took the Whales alongside and cut them
in and got supper and set the watch latter
part a strong breeze cleared away the Heads
and cleared up decks and started the works
saw three Barks and Blackfish

Thursday June 7th Pleasant with a fine breeze engaged in boiling
saw Blackfish and several sail latter part
pleasant engaged in boiling latter part finished boiling
and cleared up decks saw one Bark

Friday June 8th Pleasant engaged in clearing up decks
and various other duties latter part fine weather
saw Blackfish watches engaged in various duties
one Man died and we buried him at 8 P.M.

Saturday June 9th Pleasant weather nothing seen watches
engaged in various duties latter part pleasant
watches engaged in various duties nothing seen

Sunday June 10th Pleasant watches engaged in various duties
nothing seen latter part pleasant nothing doing

Monday June 11th Pleasant with a strong breeze nothing
seen latter part a gale from the Westward
watches engaged in stowing down oil

Tuesday June 12th Pleasant weather and blowing a gale
from the North and Westward finished stowing
down saw one spit latter part fine weather
saw Humpbacks

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Wednesday June 13th Pleasant with a strong breeze ship under
double reefed topsails and courses saw Blackfish
and Humpbacks latter part thick weather saw
Humpbacks watches engaged in mending sail

Thursday June 14th Thick weather and a strong breeze
nothing seen watches engaged in mending and
mending sails latter part a strong breeze spoke the
Bark Lagrange of Fair Haven 12 months out 4000 lbs

Friday June 15th Thick weather spoke the Bark Lagrange
latter part a strong breeze watches engaged in
various duties saw Humpbacks spoke the Lagrange

Saturday June 16th Thick weather and a strong breeze ship
under double reefed topsails and courses
latter part a strong breeze nothing doing

Sunday June 17th A strong breeze ship under double
reefed topsails and courses latter part pleasant
with light wind at 10 P.M. raised steam
Whales lowered the Boats and the Harbour
and Waist Boats struck one the Bow
Boat got stove

Monday June 18th A strong breeze took the Whales
alongside and cut them in then got
supper and set the Watch for the night
four watches latter part calld all hand
and cleared away the heads and started the works

Tuesday June 19th A strong breeze engaged in boiling saw
two schools of Blackfish latter part with the same

Wednesday June 20th A strong breeze finished boiling and
cleared up decks latter part a strong breeze
watches engaged in various duties

Thursday June 21st A strong breeze ship under
easy sail nothing seen but a Steamer
latter part light air and thick fog
saw Sulphur Bottom and Sharfish
