Wednesday July 27th Pleasant nothing seen latter part pleasant raised whales supposed to be sperm whales but proved to be Tumpas.

Thursday 26th Pleasant with a strong breeze saw Grampus and Blackfish latter part pleasant with a fine breeze saw finbacks and one Seal.

Friday July 27th Pleasant with a fine breeze spoke the Bark Mercator also saw another Bark to the leeward latter part pleasant with a light breeze engaged in various duties nothing seen.

Saturday July 28th Pleasant with light air and calms Mercator in sight latter part pleasant saw Blackfish nothing doing.

Sunday July 29th Pleasant with light air and calms nothing seen latter part pleasant saw finbacks.

Monday July 30th Pleasant with light air and calms saw Blackfish leeward and the Starboard and Larboard Boats got two apiece and the Waist and Bow Boats each got one latter part Pleasant with a fine breeze cleared away the Blackfish and missed the Blubber.

Tuesday July 31st Pleasant with a strong Breeze at noon took in the light sails and cleared up deck latter part pleasant with a strong breeze steering N.W. by N. engaged in hunting the Blackfish.

Wednesday August 1st Pleasant with a strong breeze steering N.W. by N. at 8 A.M. saw Ship and stood to the offward latter part pleasant with a strong breeze ship heading to the offward nothing seen.

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Thursday August 2nd Pleasant with a strong breeze from the N.W. ship heading to the offward on the wind nothing seen latter part pleasant nothing seen.

Friday August 3rd Pleasant with a fine breeze made all sail and sent up the Main Royal and studding sails Booms and set the foretopmast studding sail and put away for the Islands on account of several of us having a touch of the Fevery latter part pleasant with a fine breeze course N.W. by W. with studding sails below and aloft nothing seen.

Saturday August 4th Pleasant with all sail set nothing seen course N.W. by W. latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from the N.E. studding sails below and aloft.

Sunday August 5th Pleasant with a fine breeze all sail set nothing seen latter part misty weather with strong trades nothing seen.

Monday August 6th Begins with misty weather and strong trades at 7 A.M. took in all the studding sails and topgallant sails and fly jib and hoisted the Waist and Bow Boats up on the upper cranes latter part a gale took in all but close reefed Main topsail and foresail steering N.W. by S.

Tuesday August 7th Blewing a gale with a very rough sea steering N.W. by S. under close reefed Main topsail and foresail latter part more moderate set the Main topsail and Main topgallant sail.

Wednesday August 8th Thick misty weather all sail set steering S.W. by W. to keep clear of an Island land down in our track latter part Pleasant steering N.W. by S.
