

Saturday Nov 3rd Commences with strong trades double reefed to
topsails and furled the courses latter part sent in
the fly jib and mended it then bent it again

Sunday Nov 4th Strong trades ship laying off and on latter
part the same

Monday Nov 5th Strong trades and pleasant weather ship
laying off and on latter part sent the foresail
down and mended it

Tuesday Nov 6th Pleasant with strong trades ship laying
off and on bent the foresail and furled it
heard from the Capt he is better today and
expects to be on board tomorrow latter part
pleasant with strong trades engaged in setting
up the rigging

Wednesday Nov 7th Pleasant with strong trades ship under
cay sail at 4 AM Capt. came on board and
we made sail and stood to the Eastward
at sunset double reefed the topsails latter part
strong trades ship heading to the North on the
Lat 21° 48' N

Thursday Nov 8th Commences with strong trades ship under
double reefed topsails and courses jib and Spanker
latter part strong trades jiblet the jib sent it
in and sent out another and bent it also
furled the Mainsail Lat 23° 44' N

Friday Nov 9th Pleasant with strong trades engaged
in spending the jib latter part strong
trades ship heading to the N on the

Saturday Nov 10th Strong trades and pleasant
weather ship under double reefed topsails
and foresail and Spanker latter part the
same

Sunday Nov 11th Pleasant and rather more moderate ship
under single reefed topsails and courses jib and
Spanker sent down the fore and mizen topgallant
yard and trimed ship so much rugged weather
and a head beat sea that I think the leak
is gaining on her but the ship has so much
bist that we cannot tell for a certainty
but when the wind moderates we can tell very
near how much she leaks latter part pleasant
with strong trades nothing seen Lat 29° 39' N

Monday Nov 12th Pleasant with strong trades nothing seen
latter part pleasant saw a sail standing to the North
Lat 31° 14' N

Tuesday Nov 13th Pleasant with fine trades ship under whole topsails
and courses jib and Spanker latter part pleasant
all sail set nothing seen Lat 32° 58' N

Wednesday Nov 14th Pleasant all sail set now one foreback
sent down the old Mainsail and bent the
other one latter part pleasant nothing seen
Lat 34° 01' N

Thursday Nov 15th Pleasant engaged in mending the light sail
Wind light course of E by E latter part pleasant
sent up the fore and mizen topgallant yards and
sails and set them also set one foretopmast
standing sail saw foreback course of E by E
Lat 34° 27' N

Friday Nov 16th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the
N by W course N by E with fore topmast standing sail
set killed a pig latter part pleasant all light
baffling wind course N by E with topmast standing sail

Saturday Nov 17th Pleasant with light airs and calm course
N by E saw a Shark watches engaged in various
battles latter part pleasant with light wind
from the S by E course of E
