Saturday February 9th Pleasant with a strong breeze nothing seen latter a strong breeze with thick weather saw Humpbacks

Sunday February 10th Pleasant with a strong breeze and thick smoky weather saw humpbacks latter part pleasant with a strong breeze nothing seen

Monday February 11th Pleasant with a strong breeze nothing seen latter part strong breeze saw Humpbacks

Tuesday February 12th Pleasant with strong breezes saw Humpbacks latter part pleasant raised whales lowered the Larboard Boat struck and killed the other Boats continued the chase took the Whale to the ship and made him fast the other Boats came on board

Wednesday February 13th Pleasant ~~over~~ the ship off to see if we could find the Whales but without success then took in sail and cut the Whale in latter part cleared away the head and cut the Blubber up then cleared up decks and started the works

Thursday February 14th Pleasant engaged in boiling latter part finished boiling and washed up decks

Friday February 15th Pleasant with light airs and calm engaged in setting up rigging latter part fine weather and a fine breeze saw Humpbacks and one sail a Bark

Saturday February 16th Pleasant saw a Bark and some Humpbacks watches engaged in various duties latter part pleasant with a fine breeze saw Blackfish lowered and the Whist Boat got on

Sunday February 17th Pleasant saw Blackfish lowered without success watches engaged in various duties latter part thick misty weather saw plenty Blackfish got breakfast then lowered and got seven

Monday February 18th Thick rainy weather got the Blackfish alongside and hoisted them in got dinner and supper together then set the watch four watches for the night

latter part nasty rainy weather watches engaged in leaning the Blubber

Tuesday February 19th Cloudy rainy weather nothing set but maintopsail and foretopmast staysail watches engaged in leaning the blubber saw one sail supposed to be a Brig latter part fine weather at daylight started the works saw a Brig and some Humpbacks and five Blackfish

Wednesday February 20th Pleasant saw humpbacks and Blackfish finished boiling at sunset took in topgallantsails and fly jill latter part pleasant with a fine breeze saw a Brig and some humpbacks

Thursday February 21st Pleasant saw Blackfish and humpbacks watches engaged in various duties latter part pleasant with a fine breeze saw Humpbacks

Friday February 22nd Pleasant with light breezes steering various courses watches engaged in mending sails latter part pleasant steering for the Cape latter part pleasant saw humpbacks

Saturday February 23rd Pleasant with baffling winds and calm sent three Boats to tow ship toward till sunset got the Anchors off of the bows and bent the Chains already to let go latter part fine weather coopered the oil and stowed it down
