Monday February 25th Pleasant with a strong breeze saw Blackfish and Porpoises and Humpbacks latter part fine weather and a fine breeze all sail set saw Blackfish and humpbacks

Tuesday February 26th Pleasant with a fine breeze all sail set saw Blackfish watches engaged in mending the jibb latter part pleasant nothing seen ship heading to the Westward on the wind watches engaged in mending sails

Wednesday February 27th Pleasant nothing seen watches engaged in mending sails ship heading west on the Wind latter part pleasant with a fine breeze saw humpbacks

Thursday February 28th Pleasant with a fine breeze saw humpbacks latter part pleasant watches engaged in various duties

Friday February 29th Pleasant with a fine breeze saw Sulphurbottoms watches engaged in various duties latter part a fine breeze saw one finback

Saturday March 1st Pleasant with a fine breeze watches engaged in various duties nothing seen latter part pleasant with a strong breeze ship heading NW Wt on the wind

Sunday March 2nd Pleasant with a strong breeze nothing doing latter part pleasant with a strong breeze tow a hole in the Mizzen topsail sent it down and sent

Monday March 3rd Pleasant tow the Mizzen topsail sent it down and sent up the new one saw Blackfish latter part pleasant engaged in mending mizen topsail

Tuesday March 4th Pleasant with a fine breeze watches engaged in mending the mizen topsail nothing seen latter part pleasant saw finbacks watches engaged in various duties

Wednesday March 5th Pleasant with a light breeze watches engaged in setting up rigging and mending the mizen topsail saw Blackfish toward for them but saw them no more latter part pleasant with a fine breeze saw Humpbacks

Thursday March 6th Pleasant with a fine breeze saw humpbacks and Sulphurbottoms watches engaged in various duties latter part pleasant saw humpbacks watches engaged in various duties

Friday March 7th Pleasant with a fine breeze saw humpbacks watches engaged in various duties latter part pleasant nothing seen

Saturday March 8th Pleasant with light breeze nothing seen watches engaged in various duties latter part pleasant nothing seen

Sunday March 9th Pleasant with light rain squalls and the wind from the Southward watches engaged in various duties saw Humpbacks and finbacks latter part pleasant nothing seen nothing doing

Monday March 10th Commenced with light squalls and a fine breeze latter part pleasant saw Blackfish watches engaged in various duties

Tuesday March 11th Pleasant with light breeze the Land in sight saw humpbacks watches engaged in mending the Main Topgallant sail latter part pleasant saw humpbacks

Wednesday March 12th Pleasant watches engaged in various duties saw Porpoises this forenoon I went into the Porting and found an old Potato sack in there with some few old rags and some dirt and amongst the rest a small quantity of ^{meat} somewhere between seven and ten pounds I told the Captain and he called the Steward and asked him what he was a going to do with it and he said he was a going to throw it overboard
