

Remarks on Board Ship *Hibernia* Capt. J. H. Hays

Saturday May 17th 1856
The first part of these 24 hours comes in with moderate breeze from W. N. W. Ship heading N. By E. Middle part wind hauled to the N heading N. E. By E at 6 o'clock P. M. tacked ship heading N. W. By W with a strong breeze and heavy head sea running.

Sunday May 18th 1
The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze from N. N. E. Ship By the wind heading N. W. Middle and latter part light winds from N. E. By E Ship heading N. By W so ends

Monday May 19th
The first part of these 24 hours comes in with light airs and calms Ship heading N. By W Middle and latter part light airs and calms

Tuesday May 20th
Comes in with light airs and calms heading N. By W at 5 o'clock P. M. raised black-pit lowered the Boats and the harbor boat took one towed him to the ship and hoisted him in

Middle and latter part light airs and calms employed making a new galley on the starboard quarter so ends

Wednesday May 21st
Comes in with a light wind from S. E. E. Steering N. By W. Middle part light winds from South latter part from S a fine breeze moved our stern in the new galley and shored the old one so ends

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Thursday May 22nd 1856
The first part of these 24 hours comes in with fine breeze from South steering N. By W. N. W. with all sail set. Middle part the same latter part the wind hauled to N. W. with thick rainy weather ship on the wind heading N. N. E. so ends

Friday May 23.
Comes in with light from the N. W. steering N. By W. N. W. Middle and latter part calm sent down maintopsail repaired it and hoisted it again so ends calm

Saturday May 24th
The first part of this 24 hours comes in with light winds from S. E. E. steering N. N. W. Middle and latter part smooth the same employed repairing sails &c

Sunday May 25th
Comes in with moderate breezes from S. E. E. steering N. N. W. Studding sails aloft and aloft - Middle and latter part light winds from S. E. steering N. N. W. so ends

Monday May 26th
This 24 hours comes in with light breezes from S. E. steering N. N. W. Middle and latter part light variable winds and calms employed repairing sails

Tuesday May 27
Comes in with light airs and calms ship heading N. Middle part the same latter part wind hauled to N. N. E. tacked ship heading N. W. By W. overcast sky and foggy
