

Thursday July 24th
This day comes in with fine breeze
from W.S.W. Ship heading S. under all
sail at 12 tack ship heading W by N latter
part strong breeze and thick weather so ends

Friday July 25th
Comes in with strong breeze from South
Ship heading W.S.W. at 2 P.M. took in
topgallant sails and double reefed the topsails
thick rainy weather and a heavy sea running
Middle part the same at 9 o'clock took
ship heading S.E. by E latter part moderate gale
of wind ship on different tacks working to
the westward

Saturday July 26th
The first part of this day comes in with
strong breeze from S.S.W. and thick weather
Ship heading West under short sail at 9 o'clock
now ship to the southward latter part
strong breeze wore ship to the head W by N

Sunday July 27th
Comes in with moderate breezes and
thick with the wind S.W. ship under
double reefed topsails and courses heading
W.N.W. at 7 P.M. wore ship heading
S.S.E. Middle part calm at 6 A.M. to a
breeze from S.E. steering S.W. thick and
raining

Monday July 28th
Comes in with strong breezes and hauling
into the N.E. at 4 hauled the ^{top} and the wind
heading W.N.W. wind bearing to the N and N.W.
took in topgallant sails and double reefed the
topsails Middle part ship on different tacks
latter part steering to the westward with light
airs and calm

Tuesday July 29th
Comes in with light airs and calm at
3 P.M. took a breeze from the eastward
steering N for the passage through the Fox Islands
thick and rainy weather bent a new
main topsail at 10 o'clock wore ship heading S.E.
latter part strong breezes took in all sail but close
reefed main topsail heavy sea running ship running
pretty heavy and carried away our flying jibboom

Wednesday July 30th
Comes in with moderate breeze and
thick set the fore and mizen topsails
heading S.S.W. at 4 P.M. the fog cleared away
and saw the land bearing N 2 distant
5 miles one of the Fox Islands kept the
ship off steering N. through the passage
into the Kamodatska Sea (Gardie) and latter
part light winds from N.E. with foggy
Ship heading S.S.W.

Thursday July 31st
This day comes in with moderate breezes
from N.E. thick and raining ship heading
on the wind with all sail set Middle
part light winds and calms with foggy
and rain latter part calm and foggy
at 3 A.M. commenced sending down
fore topmast

Friday August 1st
Comes in with calms and foggy
at 5 P.M. got a new mast staff sails
bent and rigging set up and put
the anchors on the bows and unbent the
chain Middle part took a fine breeze
from S.W. steering N.E. latter part the
same
