Saturday August 2nd
This 24 hours comes in with fine breeze
from S.W. by S. Ship heading N.E. by E.
Middle and latter part the same

Sunday August 3rd
These 24 hours commences with fine breeze
from S ship steering N.E. Middle part
the same. at daylight spoke ship enterprise
Boiling off whale this season latter part fine
weather steering N by E.

Monday August 4th
This day comes in with moderate breezes
from S.E. steering N at 2 P.M. saw two
whales going quick to N.E. lowered board
and bow boats raised more whales from
the ship lowered the starboard boat and placed
the whale caught had ~~the~~ hooked Mr Mindell
and his boatmen out of the boat and hauled his
so he is laid up he hove his flukes in the bow
bow boat and hauled Mr Bennett and with the
bow cabinmen busy had and hauling a boatmen dory
it was took them to the ship the S.B. held
on to the whale turned him up towards the
the ship at a clock at night put 2 pulley chains
on him and let him lay, pulled all hands
at 5 A.M. and commenced cutting thick
weather weather and rain

Tuesday August 5th
Comes in with thick weather finer
cutting and set the watch made for
calm and foggy latter part the same
Clear up the decks and started the work
Mr Mindell at boatmen better Mr Bennett
and so must be very bad cannot move

Wednesday August 6th
Comes in calm and foggy employed bailing
ship out under maintop and foresail
caught a quantity of cod fish Middle and latter
part light winds and foggy

Thursday August 7th
Comes in with light winds and foggy
at 6 P.M. more ship heading E middle
and latter part the same

Friday August 8th
Comes in with light wind and foggy
at 2 P.M. the fog cleared away set the fore
and mizen topsail at 6 P.M. finished bailing
and cleaned up at 2 P.M. took in the
fore and mizen topsail and jib and set the
watch thick foggy Middle and latter part
strong breezes and thick weather

Saturday August 9th
Comes in with strong breeze from S.E.W.
and the weather ship under short sail saw
ship in sight Middle and latter thick weather
and strong breezes

Sunday August 10th
Comes in with strong breezes and thick
weather ship on different tacks making to N.W.
spoke ships Japan and Linaport Middle part Calms
and light winds latter part fine weather
commence stowing down sail saw whales down
but could not strike
