

Sunday September 21st
Comes in with moderate breeze from the westward steering South Middle part fine weather latter part the same steering S.E. saw plenty of fin and hump backs the Capt. shoulder very painful.

Monday September 22nd
Comes in with light breeze from the westward steering S.E. Middle and latter part light winds and calms finished steering down air

Tuesday September 23rd
Commenced with a light breeze from the eastward heading S by E Middle part strong breeze took in topgallant sail and Main sail and double reefed the topsails latter part strong breeze ship heading S.E.

Wednesday September 24th
Comes in with strong breeze from the eastward took in fore and Mizzen topsails wore ship heading N.N.E. latter part strong breeze at 9 AM wore ship heading S.E. by E.

Thursday September 25th
Comes in with moderate breeze from the eastward set the main sail and fore and Mizzen topsails at 9 o'clock wore ship heading N and wore ship again at 2 heading E.S.E. latter part strong breeze

Friday September 26th
Comes in with strong breeze from N.E. steering S.E. by E. at 3 P.M. saw one of the Fox Islands by S.E. distance 15 miles ship heading through the passage to the Pacific ocean at 9 o'clock bore out of sight a star Middle and latter part strong breeze and a heavy sea steering S.E. by E.

Saturday September 27th
Comes in with a strong breeze from North ship steering E.S.E. Middle and latter moderate breeze from the northward and fine weather unbent the main sail and repaired it and bent it again

Sunday Sept 28th
Comes in with a moderate breeze from the northward and fine weather steering E by S. Middle and latter part light winds and calms

Monday September 29th
Comes in with light winds and calm Middle part the same latter part took a breeze from E.N.E. took in topgallant sails and double reefed the topsails ship heading S.E.

Tuesday September 30th
Comes in with a strong breeze and thick rainy weather took in main sail fore and Mizzen topsails steering S.E. wind increased to a strong gale with a very bad sea at 3 P.M. took in the foresail and close reefed the main topsail and brought the ship to the wind heading S.E. by E. Middle part moderating latter part light winds made sail heading S.E. by E.

Wednesday Sept 1st
Comes in with light winds from N.E. and thick rainy weather at 3 P.M. wind hauled to N.N.W. steering east Middle and latter part moderate breeze and fine weather
