

Thursday Feb 5th
Pleasant with light air and calms inside
light breeze from Blackfish three Boats started
the Harbour Boat saved him and the other
Boats drove latter part pleasant with
a strong breeze steering of East

Friday February 6th
Pleasant with a strong breeze all sail set
steering of E nothing seen latter part sailing
with a strong breeze ship under easy sail

Saturday February 7th
Pleasant with a strong breeze from the Southward
course NNE all sail set nothing seen latter part
pleasant with a fine breeze spoke the ship
Desdemona 300 sperm saw several other ships steering
to the NE

Sunday February 8th
Commenced with strong breeze and squally weather
double yefed the topsails saw five ships steering
to the NE latter part pleasant saw five ships
steering to the NE signalled the Sea gull

Monday February 9th
Pleasant with light winds ship steering
course saw finbacks and some ships steering of
latter part pleasant nothing seen

Tuesday February 10th
Pleasant with light air and calms nothing
seen latter part pleasant with light air saw
Blackfish

Wednesday February 11th
Pleasant with light air and calms
course ENE latter part pleasant with
light air and calms

Thursday February 12th
Pleasant with light air and calms
latter part the same ship leaps about
90 strokes an hour

Friday February 13th
Pleasant with light air and calms nothing seen
latter part pleasant with calms nothing seen nothing doing

Saturday February 14th
Pleasant with light air and calms latter part light air and
calms nothing doing nothing seen

Sunday February 15th
Pleasant with a light breeze saw a Bark under short
sail steering different ways latter part pleasant nothing
seen

Monday February 16th
Pleasant with light wind and pleasant weather
nothing seen latter part pleasant with strong breeze
from the Southward exchanged signals with a Bark
showing a Blue White and Red signal

Tuesday February 17th
Pleasant with a strong breeze ship under double
reefed topsails course and jib nothing seen at
sunset took in the jib and Mainmast latter part pleasant
with a strong breeze at 6 PM raised sperm Whales going
quick to windward called all hand and made sail
to beat up to them at 7 PM were ship when some
of the men commenced grumbling and allowed they had
nothing to eat they went forward and after breakfast
they came aft and said they had made up their mind
not to whale it nor yet take the ship around Cape
Horn they have given up whaling altogether and have
said before that they were in a Merchantman and
one allowed he wanted wages after they all shipped
at Oahu for a cruise and home without any wages
whales went to the windward so we did not lower
for them as we cant whale it without men

Lat 32 30th
Wednesday February 18th
Blowing fresh with light rain squalls took in the
fore and mizen topsails latter part pleasant with a
strong breeze saw another sail at 10 PM set the fore
and mizen topsails Mainmast and jib

Thursday February 19th
Pleasant with a strong breeze nothing seen
latter part pleasant with light wind hove out the
Bee to overhaul it
