

Wednesday March 4th

Pleasant with a fine breeze from the N.W. course E by S watches engaged in mending sails nothing seen latter part pleasant with a fine breeze all sail set course E by S Ship leaks about 125 strokes an hour

Thursday March 5th

Pleasant with light wind from the Westward course E by S all sail set nothing doing latter part rainy with light breeze

Friday March 6th

Commences with a fine breeze from the Southward course E by N ship under fore and main topsails courses and jib latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from the Southward all sail set ship heading E by N

Saturday March 7th

Pleasant with a fine breeze from the Southward ship heading E by N on the wind latter part with the wind from the S.E. ship heading E by N on the wind

Sunday March 8th

Pleasant with the wind from the E.S.E. ship heading N.E. on the wind at 6 A.M. reefed the topsails latter part strong breeze from the E.N.E. ship heading S.E. on the wind under short sail

Monday March 9th

Commences with a light gale from the E.N.E. ship under short sail heading S.E. on the wind middle part a strong gale from the Eastward ship under close reefed fore and fore topmast staysail latter part moderate

Tuesday March 10th

Commences with thick fog and a strong breeze from the N.W. course E by S under foresail close reefed fore topsail and double reefed main topsail latter part thick with a strong breeze from the N.W. course E by S leaks about 125 strokes an hour

Wednesday March 11th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. course E by S latter part pleasant with a fine breeze course E by S

Thursday March 12th

Pleasant with a strong breeze from the Southward ship on the wind heading E by N in this last gale of March the 9th the ship labored heavy and tumbled about a great deal and started the oil a leaking bad so that every time we pump the ship we pump considerable oil as well as water latter part fine weather and a fine breeze from the Eastward ship heading to the Southward and Eastward on the wind

Friday March 13th

Pleasant with a fine breeze from N.W. course E by S all sail set nothing doing latter part wind the same course E by S nothing doing

Saturday March 14th

Commences with light wind from the N.E. ship on the wind heading to the S.E. with light rain engaged in making a new false sail and new Pinn latter part pleasant and calm sent down the foretopsail and sent up another some of the men complaining about the meat again but it is good American Meat and good enough for anybody

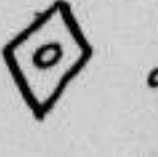
Sunday March 15th

Commences with light mist and a light breeze from the N.W. course E all sail set latter part light winds with light rain squalls

Monday March 16th

Commences with a strong breeze from the N.W. course East latter part fine weather and a light breeze from S.W. course E by N all sail set today the men brought the Beef aft and allowed they could not eat it

Tuesday March 17th

Pleasant with light breeze from the N.W. course E by N after dinner called all hands aft and took the names of all that would not eat the beef and they used very insulting language to the Captain and allowed he would have to take his ship into Port himself if they did not get good provisions and would have to pump his damned old leaky box too. I call it good Beef and Mr. Lambert and all hands aft says it is good it is Beef we bought about seventeen months ago in Cebu marked  on the head
