

Ship *Hibernia* from *Sababana* towards *Pitt* Bedford

Wednesday 1st May 1857

Commenced with fresh breeze from SSE and cloudy weather
Latter part light winds from the South and cloudy weather all sail set
No 6th

Thursday 7th

Commenced with light winds from SSE and cloudy ship heading
to the SW

Latter part light breeze from SE and pleasant weather S 6th

Obtained 27° 35' S

Friday 8th

Commenced with light airs from SE and pleasant weather course S 6th

Latter part calm Ob. Lat 38° 05' South

Saturday 9th

Commenced calm latter part light breeze from NW all sail set

Course SSE to End Ob. Lat 35° 45' S

Sunday 10th

Commenced with light breeze from NW and cloudy

Latter part strong winds from N & NW and cloudy weather course
S 6th

Monday 11th

Commenced with a strong wind from N & NW latter part light
rain latter part blowing from N & NW with a high sea running up
the jib and mainsail course SSE under double reef to End Ob. Lat 43° 35' S

Tuesday 12th

Commenced with a gale from NW at 2 PM took in fore and main topsails
saw a bark latter part more moderate bent a new mainsail and
fore topsail and all sail set Ob. Lat 45° 31' S

Wednesday 13th

a bark steering southward

Latter part fresh breeze from the NW and cloudy weather all sail
set course SSE to End Ob. Lat 47° 55' S

Thursday 14th

Commenced much the same latter part light blowing winds from
N & NW to NW some rain to End Ob. Lat 49° 23' South

Friday 15th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the NW course SE at 2 PM
wind shifted in steering sails

Latter part strong breeze from the South at 1 PM took in top sails

at 2 PM wind from SE was ship to SW double reefed the topsails at 3 PM
took in jib and mainsail to End Ob. Lat 50° 54' S

Saturday 16th

Commenced more moderate was ship to the Eastward at 2 PM all
sail set saw a bark to the SE

Latter light breeze from NW and cloudy weather course S to all sail
to End

Sunday 17th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N & NW and cloudy course S 6th

First of the latter part strong winds from NW at 5 PM wind from
the South took in the steering sails and rain

Monday 18th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from SSE at 4 PM wind N & SE

latter part blowing strong and veering from SE to W with squalls
of wind and rain under her topsails fore course set and jib sail saw a bark
heading to the SE at 6 PM Ob. Lat 52° 45' S

Remarks on Tuesday May 19th 1857

Commenced with a strong breeze from the westward with hail
squalls course SE at 3 PM took in fore & main topsails
First of the latter part blowing strong from the westward with rain hail & squalls
End moderate No 6th

Wednesday 20th

Commenced with light breeze from the southward all sail set course East
Latter part blowing a gale from NW and thick weather ship under
double reefed topsails courses and jib to End course East

Thursday 21st

Commenced the same at 1 PM took in the courses and jib course
N & E latter part wind from the westward and more moderate all
sail set course N & E to End Ob. Lat 47° 14' S Long 44° 22' W

Friday 22nd

Commenced with light breeze from the westward and cloudy weather
Latter part blowing strong and veering from NW to SW with heavy squalls
of wind and rain took in sail as was necessary to use N & E
to End

Saturday 23rd

Commenced much the same at 2 PM ship under two double reefed
topsails and fore sail course N & E wind SE

Latter part strong winds from SW some squalls course N & E ship under what
sail she would bear saw a bark steering N & E to End
Ob. Lat 54° 50' S

Sunday 24th

Commenced with a strong wind from NW at 4 PM squalls took in the
Main Top sail and fore jib course N & E at 7 PM wind increasing double
reefed the topsails at 9 PM took in the courses and jib at 10 PM it blew a gale
from NW close reefed the fore and main topsails main top sail fore
course set

Latter part more moderate ship under double reefed topsails courses and
jib course N & E to End Ob. Lat 52° 50' S

Monday 25th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from NW and thick weather course
N & E

Latter part strong winds from the westward and heavy weather to End
Ob. Lat 50° 52' S

Tuesday 26th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the westward under the Main Top
sail bent a new one course N & E

Latter part light winds from the N & NW to North and thick weather
ship heading to the Eastward all sail set to End
No 6th

Wednesday 27th

Commenced much the same latter part light winds from the NW
and cloudy weather to End No 6th

Thursday 28th

Commenced with light winds from SE and cloudy course N & E

Latter part blowing strong from the SE and rain at 8 PM took in the
Main top gallant sail and fore jib at 9 PM double reefed the topsails
took in the jib and mainsail and main topsail course N & E
to End

Friday 29th

Commenced with a strong winds from the South with hail squalls
at 1 PM turned the rips and up the main topsails set the Main Top
course N & E

Latter part blowing strong from NW with heavy squalls of wind and rain
to End

Saturday 30th

Commenced with a strong wind from NW at 2 PM wind shifted course
N & E latter part strong winds from NW and clear ship under double
reefed topsails courses and jib to End Ob. Lat 44° 13' South
