

Ship Hibernia from Salachana towards New Bedford John M. Brunnerwell Master 1857

Monday 22nd
Commences with a strong wind from SW and cloudy weather stead to the westward at 4 P.M. kept off NW
Latter part light breeze from SW and cloudy weather saw a steamship steering to the Southward So End

Ob. Lat 16° 04' S
Tuesday 23rd

Commences with light breeze from SW to SE and 4 P.M. calm with heavy showers of rain

Latter part light winds from ENE and pleasant weather saw a bark standing to the South So End

Ob. Lat 15° 01' S

Wednesday 24th

Commences with light breeze from ENE and pleasant weather saw a three masted schooner standing to the southward at 8 P.M. wind ESE course NE

Latter part light winds and varying from NE to East ship in different tracks So End

Ob. Lat 13° 50' S

Thursday 25th

Commences the same saw a bark
Latter part light winds from ESE and pleasant weather So End

Ob. Lat 12° 50' S
Friday 26th

Commences with light breeze from ENE and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. wind ESE ship by the wind to the NE and then

Latter part light breeze from SE and pleasant weather course ENE So End

Ob. Lat 11° 54' S

Saturday 27th

Commences with a light breeze from SE and 5 P.M. wind ESE

Latter part fresh breeze from SE by E and pleasant weather course NE
saw a ship steering Southward So End

Ob. Lat 10° 31' S

Sunday 28th

Commences with a strong breeze from SE by E saw a ship steering to the South

Latter part fresh breeze from SE saw a ship heading to the SW So End

Ob. Lat 8° 17' S

Monday 29th

Commences with a fresh breeze from SE and heavy weather 3 sail in sight at 2 P.M. saw Cape St Augustine bearing East at 300 course NE by N

Latter part fresh breeze from SE and pleasant weather and the Studding sail course NE by N So End

Ob. Lat 5° 47' S

Tuesday 30th

Commences with fresh breeze from SE and pleasant weather course NE

Latter part strong winds and varying from ESE to SE saw a ship heading to the Westward So End

Ob. Lat 2° 22' S

Wednesday July 1st 1857

Commences with a strong breeze from SE and squally at 5 P.M. took in studding sails and set one fore course and another course North saw a Brig standing to the Eastward

Latter part strong winds from SE and pleasant weather set the studding sails course NE and saw a ship steering Westward So End

Ob. Lat 11° 10' South

Thursday 2nd

Commences with a strong wind from SE and clear weather
Latter part fresh breeze from ESE to SE by S and squally course NE
all sail set So End

Ob. Lat 2° 44' North

Friday 3rd

Commences much the same fixed of the latter part light winds and East attended with squalls of wind and rain and calm

Ob. Lat 7° 27' N

Saturday 4th

Commences calm at 4 P.M. took a breeze from SE with rain and 8 P.M. calm

Latter part light breeze from ESE to NE So End

Ob. Lat 00° 00'

Sunday 5th

Commences with a light breeze from ENE ship heading to the Northward by the wind

Latter part light baffling winds from East to ENE with rain squalls So End

Ob. Lat 6° 22' North

Monday 6th

Commences with light air at East
Latter part calm with heavy rain So End

Ob. Lat 00° 00'

Tuesday 7th

Commences calm at 4 P.M. took a breeze from ESE with rain course NE by E

Latter calm So End

Ob. Lat 7° 54' N

Wednesday 8th

Commences with a light breeze from ESE and pleasant weather and the studding sails boarded the whaling bark by the name of New Bedford from Salachana per the Brigadier 1300 of 30. 1000 and

Latter part light breeze from ENE and pleasant weather employed in making seizing stift So End

Ob. Lat 8° 50' N

Thursday 9th

Commences much the same
Latter part light breeze from ENE and pleasant weather and set the studding sails course NE by N So End employed in fitting rigging

Ob. Lat 9° 42' N

Friday 10th

Commences with light winds from ENE with rain squalls
Latter part light winds and pleasant weather course NE employed in the rigging So End

Ob. Lat 10° 15' N

Saturday 11th

Commences with a light breeze from ENE course NE
Latter part strong breeze from SE and cloudy weather course NE
employed in fitting rigging So End

Ob. Lat 11° 48' N
