

Remarks On Board Ship *Latissima*
Monday Jan the 20 1846

The first of these 24 hours light
winds steering *W* & saw blackfish
the middle steering *S* *W* & the
latter light winds steering *W* &
N *W* *E* Lat 2-46 L 50-42

Tuesday Jan the 21 1846
These 24 hours light winds steering
to the *W* & saw blackfish

Lat 2-59 L 50-42

Wednesday July the 1st

The first of these 24 hours light
winds steering *W* & saw a brigg
at 4 P.M. saw whale and lower
at 6 P.M. the *W* & Boat struck
at 7 took the whale alongside
the middle light winds
the latter light winds we cut in
the whale and stood to the *S* *W* &
saw blackfish and the brigg

Thursday July the 2 1846

The first of these 24 hours light
winds we commenced boiling we saw
horns and Chatham Islands the
middle light winds heading to the
S *E* the latter light winds we took
ship and heading *W* *S* *W* we fired
at boiling Lat 1-43 L 50-42

Friday July the 3 1846

The first of these 24 hours light
winds steering *W* *N* *W* at 4
P.M. took to the *S* *E* the *W* &
Island bearing *S* *E* by *W* dist 25 miles
the middle light winds the latter
light winds heading *S* *E* *E*

Lat 1-34 L 50-42

Falmouth Ireland R Jones Master
Monday July the 15 1846

The first of these 24 hours fire saw
1 sail the middle and latter fire
at 9 A.M. we spoke the *Ann* *Claxton*
of *N* *B* 86 miles out 100 *S* *W* *W*
she was a boiling *Abbermar* dist
25 miles saw 2 more ships Lat

Tuesday July the 16 1846

The first of these 24 hours light
winds we spoke the *Cotnam* of
N *W* 23 miles out 1000 or had 100
when on the middle and latter
light winds saw 3 ships fire
and a third Lat 2-11 L 50-42

Wednesday July the 17 1846

The first of these 24 hours fire at
4 P.M. we spoke the *Plants* of *N* *W*
22 miles out 1000 *S* *W* *W* a head
at 6 we spoke the *Cotnam* of the
the middle and latter fire at we
spoke saw 4 ships Lat 6-11 L 50-42
the *W* & the first of *Abbermar* bearing
N *E* dist 6 miles

Thursday July the 18 1846

The first of these 24 hours fire a boat
went a fishing and a board for a
fire bars but did not strike the
middle and latter fire we saw 2 ships
Redoubt *Rock* bearing *S* *W* *E* Lat 6-11 L 50-42

Friday July the 19 1846

The first of these 24 hours steering
light winds steering to the *N* *E*
at 4 P.M. we spoke the *Cotnam* of
N *W* 22 miles out 1500 *S* *W* *W*
the middle and latter light
winds and cables saw 2 ships
Abbermar in sight
