Thursday Apr the 25<sup>th</sup> 1847

The first of these 24 hours light wind from N. at 5 AM the boat returned with some fish the Mary returned and Mary of Edgar town in company the middle light wind and squally the latter light wind from S. at 11 AM I saw 2 packs and blackfish I saw 2 persons in sight Lat 32-56 Long 76-21

Friday Apr the 26<sup>th</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind from the westward steering S. by E and by S. saw a whale Lat 31-54 Long 75-55

Saturday Apr the 27<sup>th</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind from W. at 11 AM steering N. by E I saw the boat employed in ship duty Lat 30-25 Long 75-20

Sunday Apr the 28<sup>th</sup> 1847  
The first of these 24 hours I saw for blackfish the S. boat got 1 black fish the S. boat got 1 black fish the middle and latter  Lat 29-45 Long 74-25

Monday Apr the 29<sup>th</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind steering N. at 11 AM the latter boiling blackfish we took in the S. boat I saw 2 blackfish Lat 28-02 Long 74-02

Tuesday Apr the 30<sup>th</sup> 1847  
The first of these 24 hours light wind from S. by E steering N. the middle strong wind the latter strong wind from S. by E steering N. I saw a fishback and the Carpenter repairing the boat I saw 1 fish Lat 27-25 Long 73-25

Wednesday Apr the 28<sup>th</sup> 1847

Thursday Apr the 29<sup>th</sup> 1847

Friday Apr the 30<sup>th</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours no light wind from S. by E steering N. by E I saw blackfish cloudy weather Lat 23-08 Long 74-12

Saturday May the 1<sup>st</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind from S. by E steering N. by E I saw blackfish Lat 22-08 Long 73-12

Sunday May the 2<sup>nd</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind from S. by E steering N. by E I saw fishbacks Lat 21-08 Long 72-12

Monday May the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind from S. by E steering N. by E the latter sent down the fore royal yard and mast and topgallant yard and mast and sent down the lower topmast backstays saw porpoise Lat 20-20 Long 71-12

Tuesday May the 4<sup>th</sup> 1847  
The first of these 24 hours sent up the other backstays and sent up the topmast mast and yard and set up the rigging the middle and latter light wind steering N. by E we sent up the fore royal mast and yard Lat 19-40 Long 70-12

Wednesday May the 5<sup>th</sup> 1847  
These 24 hours light wind the latter we hoisted for blackfish the S. boat got 1 the S. boat got 1  I saw 2 fish and 2 swordfish Lat 19-29 Long 69-15
