These 24 hours strong wind from the NW
W saw fin backs Lat 43-25 Long 75-25

Sunday Nov the 21st 1847
These 24 hours strong wind from the NW
W saw some rain

Lat 43-51 Long 75-52

Monday Nov the 22nd 1847
The first of these 24 hours strong wind
saw a right whale going quick to the
windward saw blackish we spoke the
Mountain of N. H. 27 in the afternoon
saw another ship the latter light
winds saw 6 sails and fin backs the
Mountain was a boiling we caught a
porpoise Lat 44-08 Long 75-25

Tuesday Nov the 23rd 1847
The first of these 24 hours we looked
for a while did not strike saw a
barque a hawking the latter light
winds from the NW saw fin backs
sails and sail we caught 4 porpoises
Lat 47-40 Long 75-21

Wednesday Nov the 24th 1847
The first of these 24 hours light winds
the latter light winds from the NW
saw a right whale at 4. it all
board it is the Bow Boat struck it
to take the whale along side and commenced
cutting saw 2 sails the Island of
Kauai in sight Lat 48-55 Long 75-25

Thursday Nov the 25th 1847
The first of these 24 hours we finished
cutting a boat came on board from the
Ship S. S. Image of Cold Spring 28
miles out 1750 W. 1000 from the latter we
commenced boiling saw fin backs and sail
the wind NW by W Lat 49-50 Long 75-25

Friday Dec the 2nd 1847
The first of these 24 hours strong
winds from NW by W and rain heading
S W by S the latter light winds and
thick weather heading to the North the
land in sight saw 1 sail Lat 49-50

Saturday Dec the 3rd 1847
The first of these 24 hours light winds
from S and thick weather saw blackish
the latter strong winds from
S W steering 11° 30' saw some
backs lifting new gill whips
Lat 39-27 Long 75-25

Sunday Dec the 4th 1847
These 24 hours strong breezes from
S W steering to the Northward
the latter saw the land and
sharp backs Aloha bearing 11° 30'
dist 14 miles Lat 38-27 Long 75-25

Monday Dec the 5th 1847
These 24 hours strong wind from S W
heading S W by W Lat 28-23 Long 75-25

Tuesday Dec the 6th 1847
These 24 hours light winds and fine
weather saw fin backs heading to the S W
Lat 28-23 Long 75-25

Wednesday Dec the 7th 1847
The first of these 24 hours light winds
from S W heading S W by W Lat 27-25
headed to the North the latter fine
the wind S W by W heading 11° W Lat
10 N kept of S W saw blackish
and fin backs Lat 38-28 Long 75-25
