heading North the watches watching down

Friday Mar the 17th 1848
These 24 hours light breeze from E by S
heading N by E the latter we saw a sail
watching and trying rigging fine weather

Saturday Apr the 1st 1848
These 24 hours light winds and some
rain squalls we sent up the foretopgall
Mast yard and sent down the
