Friday 14 Day of August



The first part of these 24 hours light breezes & some cloudy middle part some showing the first part saw a ship & barke steering to the Eastward At 6 A.M. the lookout from the mast saw a shoale of Blackfish lowerd away all 4 Boats & caught 1 by the L. B. Boats here 24 hours ends with a fine breeze & pleasant weather All hands employed in ships duty Course steerd E.S.E. by Compass

Saturday 15

All these 24 hours light breezes from S.W. & pleasant weather All hands employed in ships duty Sheathing Decks fitting Boats cutting gear & other necessary work - At 10 A.M. saw a English Brig steering to the W. & East Course E.S.E.

Sunday 16

All these 24 hours fine winds from the S.W. & pleasant weather saw a Brig steering to the N.E. At 5 A.M. raised a school of Sperm whales lowerd away all 4 Boats & took three by L. B. & B. Boats at the Meridian had them cut in

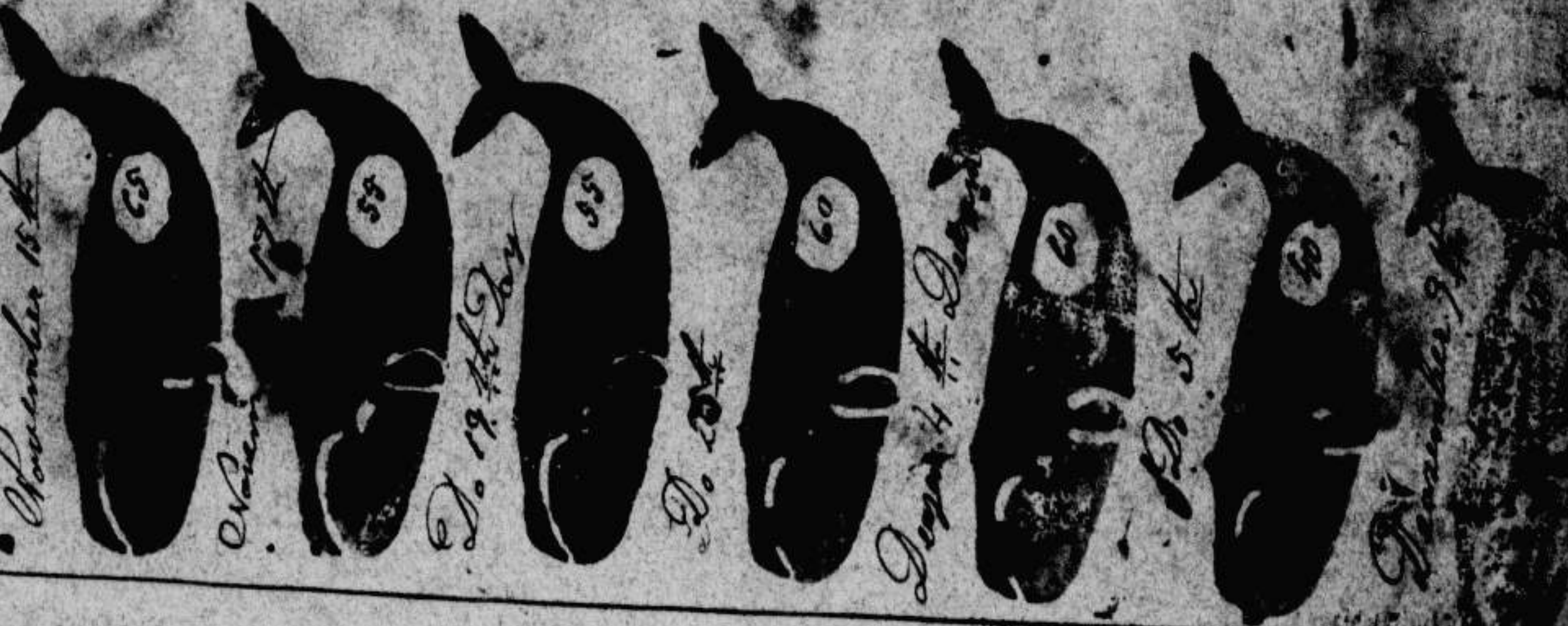
