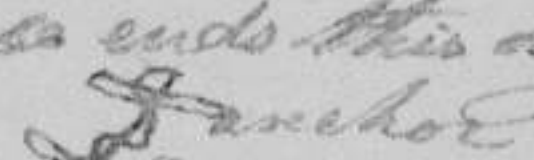
Wednesday May the 12 all of this Day fine weather and the larboard watch on shore on liberty nothing remarkable to day so ends this day 

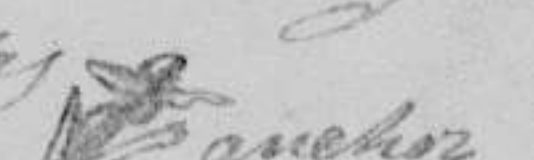
Thursday May the 13 A.M. of this day fine weather and the Starboard watch on shore on liberty so ends 24 hours 

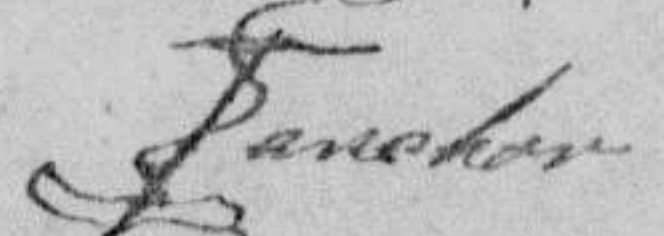
Friday May the 14th A.M. of this day fine weather and the Larboard watch on shore on liberty employed at nothing so ends this day 

Saturday May the 15th A.M. of this day fine weather and the Starboard watch on shore on liberty so ends this day 

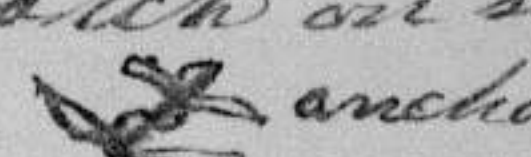

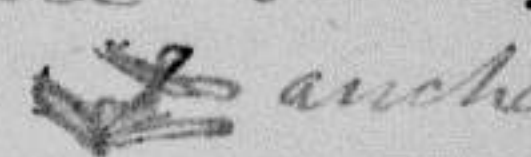

Thursday May 20th A.M. of this day fine weather and the Larboard watch on shore and the starboard watch boating off recruits employed painting the waist boat finished painting the Starboard and Larboard so ends this day 

Friday May 21st A.M. of this day pleasant weather employed hanning up recruits and stowing away things Starboard watch on shore so ends 24 hours 

Saturday May 22nd A.M. of this day fine weather and the Larboard watch on shore on liberty so ends this day 

Sunday May 23rd A.M. of this day pleasant and all hands gone to church the Starboard watch on shore so ends 24 hours 

Monday May 24 A.M. of this pleasant and the Larboard watch on shore employed firing off canons for it is the queens birth day flags flying from all the ships in port so ends this day 

Tuesday May the 25 all of this day fine weather and all hands on board employed getting the ship out into the outer harbor then looking at the shore so that ends this Day 

Wednesday May the 26 all of this day fine weather and all hands employed getting ready to go to sea and at 9 P.M. took our anchor and went and left all the sweet hearts behind steering north by East so ends this Day
