

Bark Hope in the indian Ocean 1852

Friday September the 3 all of this day strong breezes from the south & west heading south East with rough squally rainy weather saw nothing employed blowing out the whales the cooper out his barrel with a spade broke out for water so ends this Day Latitude $01^{\circ}32'$ south Longitude $43^{\circ}49'$ East

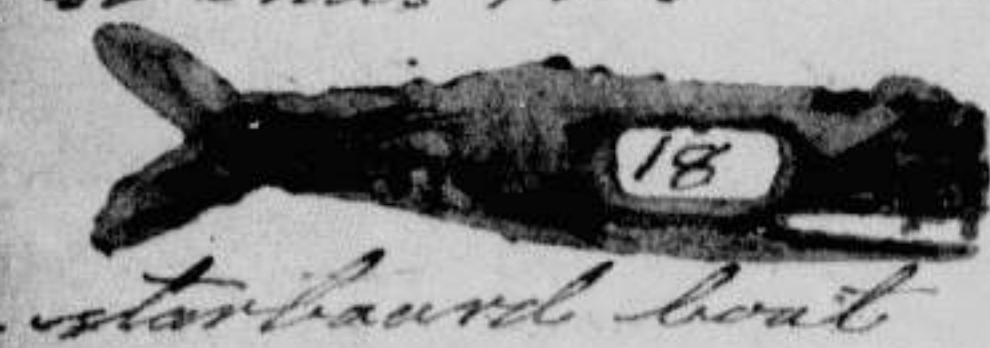
Saturday September the 4 all of this day strong breezes from the south & East heading East & East and south west with rough weather and squalls of rain finished blowing out the whales at 10 P.M. saw black fish so ends this Day Latitude $01^{\circ}36'$ south Longitude $43^{\circ}22'$ East

Sunday September the 5 all of this day strong breezes from the south & East with rough squally weather and rain heading East and south west broke out for beer saw nothing so ends this Day Latitude $01^{\circ}59'$ south Longitude $42^{\circ}59'$ East

Monday September the 6 all of this day strong breezes from the south & East with fine weather heading East at 3 P.M. took ship to the south west at 5 P.M. saw sperm whales and lowered for them the larboard boat got fast and d'neal employed cooping the oil and broke the water out of the fore hole so ends this Day started 4 casks of beer



Tuesday September the 7 all of this day fine weather and light breezes from the south & East heading East and south west at 1 P.M. saw sperm whales and lowered the boats and caught 3 and took them along and out them in and stored some oil down between decks so ends this hard days work Latitude $02^{\circ}05'$ south Longitude $42^{\circ}51'$ East

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Wednesday September the 8 all of this day strong breezes from the south & East heading to the Eastward and westward with clear weather employed blowing out the whales and set up two pipe sheels saw lineages and killed a pig so ends this Day Latitude $02^{\circ}17'$ south Longitude $42^{\circ}30'$ East

Thursday September the 9 all of this day strong breezes from the south & East heading East and south west with rough weather and some squalls of rain finished blowing out the whales at 1 P.M. employed storing down oil in the fore peak the rest of the day saw nothing so ends this Day Latitude $02^{\circ}20'$ south Longitude $42^{\circ}35'$ East

Friday September the 10 all of this day strong breezes from the south & East with rough squally weather and some rain heading East and south west employed storing down oil in the fore hole and finished it off full of sperm oil saw nothing so ends this Day Latitude $02^{\circ}20'$ south Longitude $42^{\circ}25'$ East

Saturday September the 11 all of this day strong breezes from the south with rough weather under double reefed top sails heading East & East at 6 P.M. took ship to the west south west employed lining out and storing of between decks and broke out for beer and pork and water and caught some fish so ends this Day Latitude $02^{\circ}06'$ south Longitude $41^{\circ}57'$ East

Sunday September the 12 all of this day strong breezes from the south & west with rough bad weather and some squalls of wind and rain heading south west and East under double reefed top sails at 4 P.M. saw the coast of africa so ends this Day Latitude $01^{\circ}38'$ south Longitude $42^{\circ}34'$ East
