

Tuesday February the 15th all of this day strong gales from the south S. East employed doing nothing so ends this day blowing a terrible gale of wind hard times   anchor

East with rough weather and the starboard watch on shore on liberty had some company on board from the steamer great Britain some of our men are on board of the great Britain to work for the night so ends this Day   anchor



Thursday February the 17th all of this day fine weather and the starboard watch on shore on liberty two of our men run a way to day employed a nothing so ends this day   anchor



Friday February the 18th All of this day fine weather and the starboard watch a shore on liberty employed beating of water and took it aboard had some company from the steamer so ends this day   anchor


Sunday February the 20th all of this day strong gale and the starboard watch on shore on liberty nothing more of consequence so this day ends   anchor




Monday February the 21st all of this day fine weather and the starboard watch on shore on liberty so ends this Day   anchor



Tuesday February the 22nd all of this day fine weather and the starboard watch on shore on liberty so ends this day   anchor
