All this 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather
Brig on the wind heading SE wind SSW at 6 AM
took in fore top gallant sail and mainsail mast
heads maned on the lookout for whales

Lat 7 33 South Long 9 40 East

Remarks on Board June 8th

All this 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather
Brig on the wind heading SE by E wind SSW
at sunset took in sail at 11 AM saw a schooner to westward

Lat 7 20 South Long 10 44 East

Remarks on Board Wednesday June 9th

first part of this 24 hours light winds with pleasant weather
wind SSW heading SE by E at 6 AM spoke ship marion of
New Bedford latter pleasant and calm mastheads maned
on the lookout for whales

Lat 7 12 South Long 11 East

Remarks on Board Thursday June 10

first part of these 24 hours calm with pleasant
Weather latter part light baffling winds and
Cloudy course ESE saw nothing to day

Lat 6 39 South Long 11 50 East

Remarks on Board Friday June 11

All this 24 hours light Winds and pleasant Weather
Wind from south to SSW course East at 8 AM
saw two Barks to the Eastward at 11 AM saw the land
Bearing ESE distant 10 miles

Lat 6 7 South Long 12 11 East

Remarks on Board Saturday June 12

All this 24 hours light Winds with pleasant weather
Wind SSW course ESE at 4 PM spoke bark Osceola
of New Bedford at 6 AM anchored of Congo river
so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday June 13

this 24 hours comes in with light winds and pleasant
Weather at 4 PM came to anchor at cabenda saw
the english steamship at anchor of cabenda so ends this
day

Remarks Monday June 14

All this day fine clear Weather all hands employed
in coopering casks at 9 AM boat went on shore

Tuesday 15

All this day fine pleasant Weather all hands employed
in coopering casks

Wednesday June 16

this day fine pleasant Weather one watch went
on shore on liberty came off at sunset employed
in getting ready for sea all hands well on board
so ends this day

Thursday June 17

this day fine pleasant weather at 6 got underweigh
with wind at SSW at 8 AM the south point of Cabenda
bore SSE distant 8 miles course NW by N

Friday June 18

All this day fine pleasant weather wind at SSW at 3 AM came
to anchor in Congo Bay all hands well on board

Saturday June 19

this day comes in with fine pleasant weather
Starboard watch went on shore on liberty
came off at sunset all well

Sunday June 20

this day fine pleasant weather
Starboard watch went on shore on liberty
came off at sunset so ends this day
