Wednesday July 28

all this day thick rainy weather with wind from N.W. blowing a strong breeze in the forenoon. chast humblacks

Thursday July 29

all this day thick rainy weather with wind from N.W. blowing a strong breeze saw a number of Whales chast them all the afternoon

so ends this day

Friday July 30

first part of this day cloudy weather with wind from N.W. blowing a light breeze after part pleasant with baffling winds in afternoon struck a humblack and drewed

so ends this day

Saturday July 31

first part of this day cloudy with light baffling winds middle and latter part rainy with strong breeze from S.W. at 7 am struck a humblack and sunk him

so ends this day

Sunday August 1st

all this day thick cloudy rainy weather with light baffling winds struck a Whale and cut foul line at sundown saw two sails in shore of us

August 2nd

all this day thick cloudy weather with light baffling winds and calms at 8 am struck a Whale and parted the line

so ends this day

Tuesday August 3rd

all this day fine clear pleasant weather with light baffling winds at 2 pm struck a Whale and lost him by sharks

Wednesday August 4th

all this day fine clear pleasant weather with light winds from N.W. employed in chasing Whales

so ends this day

Thursday August 5th

all this day fine clear pleasant weather with first part calm latter part strong breeze from N.W. at 6 am struck a Whale and lost him by sharks mated with bark tropic Bird of New Bedford

so ends this day

Friday August 6th

all this day fine clear pleasant weather with wind from N.W. the first part light middle and latter part strong at 6 am struck a Whale and lost him while getting him to the brig by hall him under water sunk him

so ends this day

Saturday August 7th

fore part of this day clear pleasant weather with calm middle part rainy latter part clear with strong breeze from N.W. at 7 am got underway worked up until sunset came to again in 35 fathoms of water

so ends this day

Sunday 8

all this day fine clear pleasant weather wind from S.S.E. at 6 am got underway run up to Cape Orte anchored in 20 fathoms of water with barks

tropic bird and mary gardner

Monday August 9

this day clear pleasant weather with strong breeze from N.W. at 8 am struck a Whale and turned him parted the lines hall him up at 4 pm struck one and cut from him

so ends this day

Tuesday August 10

first part of this day dark cloudy weather with wind from N.W. middle and latter part rainy with strong breeze in forenoon chasing whales at noon came on board

so ends this day

Wednesday August 11th

first part of this day calm with clear pleasant weather middle and latter part strong breeze from S.W. at 8 am struck a whale and lost him

so ends this day

Thursday August 12

all this day fine clear pleasant weather with light baffling winds at 10 am struck a whale drewed from him

so ends this day

Friday August 13

first part of this day cloudy weather and calm middle and latter part pleasant with strong breeze from N.W. struck two whales drewed from one and cut from the other

so ends this day

Saturday August 14

first part of this day calm with pleasant weather middle and latter part strong breeze from N.W. and clear at noon blew from tropic bird struck whale in afternoon cut him in

so ends this day
