this 24 hours clear pleasant weather with moderate breeze from SW and SSW with brig on a wind with all sail set working up the coast at sunrise ~~we~~ saw a ship to southward
so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday August 30
first part of this 24 hours pleasant weather with light breeze from SW middle and latter part cloudy and rainy the brig on a wind heading WSW at 11 am saw the land bearing WSW distant 12 miles saw 5 sails under the land at noon anchored in 10 fathoms water in SW bay at prince's island so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 31

all this day fine clear pleasant weather with light baffling winds lowered the boats for whales
so ends this day

Wednesday September 1st
this day clear pleasant weather with a light breeze from SSW chased whales all day

Thursday Sept 2^d
this day clear pleasant weather with wind from SW at noon got underway worked up for antoine bay

Friday Sept 3^d

all this day fine pleasant weather with strong breeze from SW at 6 pm anchored in antoine bay in 12 fathoms of water at 9 am lowered for whales

saturday Sept 4th
all this day fine pleasant weather with baffling winds mated with bark's tropic bird mary gardner saw number of whales

sunday Sept 5th
all this day fine clear pleasant weather with wind at SW boats down for whales
so ends this day

Atlantic ocean Cbed Delano Commander 1858

Monday 6th

this day fine clear pleasant weather with wind from SW at 1 pm struck a whale at 9 pm took him along side and anchored in 25 fathoms so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 7

all this day clear pleasant weather with light breeze from SW all hands employed in cutting in and getting ready for boiling

Wednesday September 8

this day pleasant weather with strong breeze from SW at 7 am struck whale at noon cut from him and came on board in the afternoon chased whales so ends this day

Thursday Sept 9

all this day a strong breeze at WSW with fine pleasant weather chased whales all day

Friday Sept 10

all this day a breeze at WSW with light cloudy weather at noon hauled a whale along side of the tropic bird

Saturday Sept 11

all the fore part of this day rainy with strong breeze from SW the middle and latter part dark and cloudy at noon lowered down for whales
so ends this day

Sunday Sept 12

this day fine clear pleasant weather with light breeze from SW at sunrise lowered the boats and cruised for whales all the fore noon saw nothing at noon came on board so ends this day

Monday Sept 13

all this day clear pleasant weather with light breeze from SW at 9 am struck a whale at 4 pm took him alongside and commenced cutting at 8 pm got him all in so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 14

all this day pleasant weather with wind at SW all hands employed in boiling and storing down oil
so ends this day
