

Brig Hopeton on Whaling Voyage in Atlantic Ocean Obid Delano Commander 1858

Remarks on Board Monday Nov 8

first part of this 24 hours moderate breeze from S to S S W with pleasant weather the brig by the wind with all sail set courses from W to W S W finished boiling saw nothing to day Lat 8 south

Remarks on Board Tuesday Nov 9 this 24 hours light moderate breeze from S W to S S W pleasant weather the brig by wind with all sail on courses from W to W S W saw nothing to day Lat 9 = 36 south

Remarks on Board Wednesday Nov 10

first part of this 24 hours light moderate breeze from S to S W with pleasant weather middle & latter thick squally weather the brig by wind with all sail set courses W to W S W saw nothing to day Lat 10 = 21 south

Remarks on Board Thursday Nov 11 this 24 hours strong breeze from S to S S E with squally weather the brig by the wind with all sail set courses W to S W by W stowed down oil saw nothing this day Lat 11 = 30 south

Remarks on Board Friday Nov 12

this 24 hours strong breeze from S to S S E with pleasant weather the brig by wind with all sail set courses from W to S W saw nothing this day Lat 12 = 18 south Long 51 m West

Remarks on Board Saturday Nov 13 all this 24 hours strong breeze from S to S S E with pleasant weather the brig on a wind heading from W by S to S W by W with all sail set all hands employed washing ship saw nothing to day Lat 13 = 2 S Long 2 = 41 W

Remarks on Board Sunday Nov 14

first part of this 24 hours strong breeze from S S W with cloudy weather middle same ends with moderate breeze and pleasant the brig with all sail set steaming W half S at 10 am saw St Helena bearing N N W distant 25 miles so ends this day Lat 16 = 41 S

Remarks on Board Monday Nov 15 all this 24 hours strong breeze from S E with pleasant weather the brig steaming for St Helena with all sail set at midnight anchored at Jamestown in 25 fathoms at 8 am capt went on shore so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday Nov 16

this 24 hours strong breeze from S S E with squalls of rain all hands employed in cleaning ship for painting

Remarks on Board Wednesday Nov 17 this 24 hours light breeze from S S E with pleasant weather employed in painting ship starboard watch on shore

Thursday Nov 18

this 24 hours strong breeze from S S E with pleasant weather hord down rigging painted spare watch on shore

Friday Nov 19

this 24 hours light breeze from S S E pleasant weather painting ship watch on shore

Saturday Nov 20

this 24 hours light breezes & S calm employed in painting boats with watch on shore

Sunday Nov 21

this day fine pleasant weather with light breeze from S to S S E one watch on shore

Monday 22

this day fine pleasant with light breeze at S S E

Tuesday Nov 23

this day fine pleasant weather with light breezes from S S E boats on board 12 bbls of beef 4 of pork 3 casks of bread 3 bbls bread 6 bbls of flour so ends this day
