first part of this 24 hours light southerly winds middle calm latter part light easterly winds course WNW at sunset took in sail for the night at sunrise made sail employed in ships duty saw nothing from mastheads to day so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday Dec 18

first part of this 24 hours light easterly winds fine and pleasant middle rainy with thunder and lightning latter part strong breeze from ENE and rainy the brig by the wind heading NW at sundown took in sail for the night sunrise made sail saw nothing to day from mastheads

Remarks on Board Sunday 19

this 24 hours strong easterly winds with pleasant weather the brig by wind heading NNE with fore top gallant sail in at 2 pm saw blackfish lowered for them did not strike so ends this day Lat 8=15 North

Remarks on Board Monday 20

all this 24 light easterly winds and fine weather courses is and SE at sunset took in sail for the night at sunrise made all sail saw nothing this day Lat 7=41 Long 16=45 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday 21

fore part of this 24 hours light easterly wind middle and latter calm with fine weather saw nothing to day Lat 7=21

first of this 24 hours calm with pleasant weather middle and latter part light breeze from SE steering NW at sunset took in sail for the night at sunrise made sail saw nothing to day from mastheads

all this 24 hours light northerly winds fine weather the brig by wind with all sail set heading WNW at sunset took in sail for the night sunrise made sail Lat 7=35 North

Remarks on Board Saturday 25

all this 24 hours light moderate northerly winds fine weather course WNW at noon saw blackfish Lat 7=19 North

Remarks on Board Sunday Dec 26

fore part of this 24 hours light baffling winds and calm clear pleasant weather middle the same ends with thick rainy weather with thunder and lightning at sunset took in sail for the night at daylight made all sail saw nothing from mastheads to day so ends this day no obs

all this 24 hours light baffling winds and calms with fine weather the brig with all sail on course WNW saw nothing from aloft to day Lat 7=33 North

first part of this 24 hours light northerly winds middle part calm ends with moderate breeze and fine weather course NW at sunset took in sail for the night at daylight made sail saw nothing to day Lat 7=20 North Long 18=8 West

first part of this 24 hours light breeze from eastward middle giddy latter part calm with pleasant weather course NW at sunset took in sail for the night saw nothing to day
