all the first part calm middle same latter strong
breeze from E with pleasant weather at 8 pm caught
one blackfish at 7 am saw schooner to eastward
Lat 7=32 North

Remarks on Board Friday 31
first part of this 24 hours light breeze from eastward middle
strong breeze and rainy with thunder and lightning ends
with strong breeze and pleasant at 8 am spoke schooner
enteric of providence town so ends this day
Lat 7=39 North Long 19=1 West

Remarks on Board Saturday Jan 1 1854
all this 24 hours moderate breeze from eastward with pleasant
weather at 9 am saw shoal of blackfish course WSW
the brig running free with all sail set so ends this day
Lat 7=19 North

Remarks on Board Sunday Jan 2
all this 24 hours light moderate breezes and calm with
pleasant weather at sunset took in sail for night
at sunrise set all sail saw nothing from mastheads to
day so ends this day
Lat 7=6 North

Remarks on Board Monday Jan 3
first part of this 24 hours calm and pleasant middle
same ends with moderate breeze from eastward at 3 pm
caught 3 blackfish so ends this day
Lat 6=59 North
Long 20=10 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday Jan 4
first part of this 24 hours calm and pleasant middle same
ends with moderate breeze from eastward course SW by W
saw two sails to eastward at sunset took in sail for the
night at sunrise made sail again
Lat 6=39 North

Atlantic ocean obed delano Com 1854
Remarks on Board Wednesday Jan 5
all this 24 hours light airs and calms with pleasant weather
at 11 pm caught 1 blackfish at 11 am saw a large shoal
3 three sails in sight to eastward took on board 3 bbl
beef 1 bbl of molasses from schooner mitaretic
Lat 6=25 North

Remarks on Board Thursday Jan 6
all this 24 hours light airs and calms with pleasant weather
at 9 am looked for blackfish did not strike saw three
sails to Northward employed in cutting up blubber
and boiling blackfish so ends this day
Lat 6=32 North

Remarks on Board Friday Jan 7
first part of this 24 hours light moderate breeze from
Eastward middle same ends with thick rainy weather
with thunder and lightning saw four sails at 3 pm
spoke brig panaman so ends this day
Lat 6=35 North
Long 20=4 West

Remarks on Board Saturday 8
all this 24 hours strong breeze from eastward
with thick rainy weather steering of WSW
with short sail out saw 4 sails
so ends the day
No observations

Remarks on Board Sunday Jan 9
all this 24 hours strong breeze from the eastward
and clear weather steering of SE by S with all sail set
saw bark steering to W at sunset took in sail for the
night so ends the day
Lat 5=26 Long 21=3 West

Remarks on Board Monday 10
all this 24 hours strong breeze from eastward with pleasant
weather the brig by wind with all sail set steering of W
at sunset took in sail for the night saw nothing to day
Lat 6=3 North
Long 21=54 West
