all this 24 hours strong breeze from eastward with fine weather the brig by wind with all sail on heading to eastward saw 4 sails took in sail for the night at sunset spoke brig march No observers

Remarks on Board Wednesday 12
all this 24 hours strong breeze from eastward fine pleasant weather the brig with all sail set steering off to S W at 11 am lowered for blackfish did not strike
so ends the day

Long 21=32 West

Remarks on Board Thursday 13

first part of this 24 hours light breeze from eastward middle and latter calm with fine weather the brig heading to Northward and Westward to sunset took in sail for the night so ends this day
Lat 6=3 North

Remarks on Board Friday 14
this 24 hours strong easterly winds and clear weather the brig by wind heading to Northward and Westward with all sail set at 10 am lowered for blackfish caught one
Lat 6=19 North
Long 22=2 West

Remarks on Board Saturday 15

all this 24 hours strong easterly winds with pleasant weather the brig on a wind heading to N N W at 7 am took ship to southward and eastward at sunset took in sail for the night at sunrise made all sail saw nothing to day
Lat 6=3 North
Long 22=19 West

Remarks on Board Sunday 16
all this 24 hours strong N E trades blowing pleasant weather the brig by wind heading to N N W with all sail set at sundown took in for night saw 3 sails spoke brig Panama mastheads made all hands well
Lat 6=23 North

Remarks on Board Monday January 17

all this 24 hours strong N E trades with pleasant weather the brig with all sail steering W by N saw 20 sails at sunset took in sail for night so ends this day
Lat 6=26 North

Remarks on Board Tuesday 18
all this 24 hours strong N E with ruff sea weather pleasant the brig with all sail steering W by N at 3 pm past brig panama steering to North
Lat 6=26 North
Long 25=3 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday 19

this 24 hours strong N E trades with heavy sea pleasant weather course W by N foretop gallant sail mainsail in at 3 pm lowered for blackfish did not strike saw 2 sails so ends this day
Lat 6=28 North

Remarks on Board Thursday 20
this 24 hours strong N E trades with heavy sea running weather pleasant the brig with mainsail in course N W saw 2 sails steering to SE so ends this day all hands well
Lat 7=18 North
Long 24=19 West

Remarks on Board Friday 21

all this 24 hours strong N E trades with heavy sloping sea the brig with all sail set steering N W half W saw nothing to day so ends the day
Lat 8=20 North

Remarks on Board Saturday 22
all this 24 hours strong N E trades heavy sea running the brig steering N W by W with all sail that will draw at 4 pm saw blackfish did not lower so ends this day

Lat 9=27 North
Long 31=21 West
