Remarks on Board Monday 24
all this 24 hours fresh N E trades with heavy sea
Weather pleasant the brig steering to W N W
with all drawing sail set saw nothing to day

Lat 10 = 58 North
Long 89 = 55 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday 25

all this 24 hours strong N E trades with heavy sea
Weather pleasant the brig steering to W by W
with all sail that draws saw nothing to day all hands well
so ends this day

Lat 11 = 35 North

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 26
this 24 hours strong N E trades with heavy sea clear Weather
the brig steering of to W by N 1/2 N with all sail set
saw nothing from mastheads to day so ends this day

Lat 11 = 54 North
Long 44 = 50 West

Remarks on Board Thursday 27

this 24 hours moderate N E trades with pleasant
Weather the brig running of to W by N with all sail
saw nothing from mastheads to day employed
mending the foresail

Lat 12 = 12 North

Remarks on Board Friday 28
this 24 hours light N E trades with pleasant Weather
the brig steering of to W 1/2 N with all sail set saw
to 20 sails to northward employed in ships duty
so ends this day

all this 24 hours light moderate winds from SE with fine
pleasant weather the brig with all sail set steering
of to W 1/2 S employed in ships duty saw nothing
from mastheads to day so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday 30
all this 24 hours light SE winds with fine pleasant Weather
the brig with all sail set steering of to W by S
saw nothing to day so ends this day

Lat 11 = 53 North

Remarks on Board Monday Jan 31

all this 24 hours light easterly winds with pleasant
Weather the brig with all sail set course W by S
all hands well employed in ships duty
saw nothing to day from mastheads so ends the day

Lat 11 = 52 North
Long 53 = 40 West

Remarks on Board Tuesday Feb
first part of this 24 hours light N E trades and equally
middle and latter parts strong trades and pleasant
the brig with all sail set course W by S saw nothing
to day

Lat 11 = 30 North

Long 55 = 55 West

Remarks on Board Wednesday Feb 20

all this 24 hours moderate N E trades with pleasant Weather
the brig with all sail set course W at 9 pm saw blackfish
did not lower for them so ends this day

Lat 11 = 39 North

Long 58 = 6 West

Remarks on Board Thursday Feb 3
all this 24 hours strong N E trades with pleasant Weather
at 11 am made the island of Tobago bearing W S W
distant 20 miles course to island W 8 W
Lat 11 = 15 North
