this day strong trades from NE squally weather at 6 am lowered for Whales one boat went to town for recruits

Remarks on Board Sunday Feb 20

at this day fine strong breeze pleasant weather at 6 am lowered for Whales at noon returned

Remarks on Board Monday Feb 21

this day laying at sandy point with strong NE trades weather pleasant at 6 am lowered for whales at 10 am Andrew J Smith deserted
also ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday Feb 22

laying at sandy point with wind at NE blowing strong at 6 am lowered for Whales about 10 struck a whale and cut from him

Remarks on Board Wednesday Feb 23

laying at sandy point with at NE blowing strong at sunrise lowered for Whales chast most part of the day

Remarks on Board Thursday Feb 24

laying at sandy point wind at NE strong breezes lowered boats for whales chast most part of the day taken on board 2 bbl of molasses so ends the day

Remarks on Board Friday Feb 25

laying at sandy point wind at NE strong breeze chast Whales most part of the day took John Turner out of irons

Remarks on Board Saturday Feb 26

laying at sandy point with strong trades clear weather at sunrise lowered for Whales chast most part of the day in afternoon took in waist boat to mend her

Remarks on Board Sunday Feb 27

laying at sandy point with strong NE trades clear weather at 6 am lowered for Whales chast until noon came on board so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday Feb 28

this day laying at sandy point with strong NE trades fore part of the day chast Whales at 14 pm struck one at 4 pm took him alongside

Remarks on Board Tuesday March

laying at sandy point with strong trades blowing employed in cutting the whale at 4 pm commenced boiling the whale so ends the day
