

Remarks On Board Ship Howard

Monday
Oct 15th 8^h This 24 hours commences with fresh breeze from the S.W. hazy weather took up the 2nd anchor at 3 P.M. till 4 P.M. again. Middle and Latter Part weak and hazy weather inclined to rain 30 sail came in to anchor employed in various jobs of ship duty so ends this day

Tuesday
Oct 16th 8^h Commences with strong wind from the S.W. attended with rain more vessels came to anchor there being about 50 sail to anchor in the Cove round to the Westward. Latter Part pleasant breeze from the N.W. all hands employed in ship duty 30 ends many sail left this day

Wednesday
Oct 17th 8^h First Part pleasant breeze from the S.W. middle sail came to anchor Middle and Latter Part pleasant weather and moderate breeze from the Westward all hands employed in ship duty

Thursday
Oct 18th 8^h First Part this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N.W. the ship took ground up round about 5 P.M. Middle Part strong breeze Latter Part pleasant light breeze from N.W. to 30 employed in ship duty

Friday
Oct 19th 8^h The first Part this 24 hours moderate breeze from the S.W. at 4 P.M. the brig ionta came in to anchor Latter Part fresh breeze from the Eastward at 8 P.M. took and anchored and went to sea with all sail 30 ends this day

Saturday
Oct 20th 8^h First Part strong wind from the E.S.E. attended with rain at 3 P.M. Double reefed the topsail Close reefed fore and Mizzen and to freshen the wind increased headed to the S.W. to the Port at 4 P.M. the wind hauled to the Westward made all sail stirring E.S.E. with the stirring sail fore and aft saw a schooner headed to the Northward
Lat 39.11

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Sunday
Oct 21st 8^h First Part this 24 hours strong breeze from the West stirring 88 under all sail at 5 P.M. saw 2 sperm whales at 6 P.M. took in the top gallant stirring sail Latter Part the wind more moderate at 5 P.M. made all sail bloody stirring 88 so ends this day

Monday
Oct 22nd 8^h First Part bloody inclined to rain the wind W by N stirring 88 under all sail at 5 P.M. saw 2 sperm whales headed to the N.W. going quick Middle Part rainy Latter Part fresh breeze from the N.W. stirring 88 all hands employed in ship duty 30 ends this day Lat 39.12

Tuesday
Oct 23rd 8^h This 24 hours commences with pleasant breeze from the N.W. all hands employed in ship duty all sail set Middle and Latter Part strong breeze and squally at 5 P.M. took in the lower and top mast stirring going at the rate of 900 knots and shore stirring 88 the wind hauled more to the North at 10 P.M. saw running 30 ends this day Lat 39.15

Wednesday
Oct 24th 8^h First Part strong breeze from the stirring 88 at 1 P.M. reefed the main sail and set it at 5 P.M. out the reef at the fore and Mizzen to top gallant sails 11 P.M. Part light air from the North Latter Part breeze from the East took up 11 P.M. all hands employed in breaking out 30 ends this 24 hours Lat 39.16

Thursday
Oct 25th 8^h Commences with strong breeze at 3 P.M. took in the fore and Mizzen top gallant sails and flying jib at 5 P.M. put in 7 reef in the fore and Mizzen top sails the wind from the South stirring East thick dark the wind hauled to the S.W. increased to gale in the squall double reefed the topsail took in the main sail and jib stirring East by compass a heavy breeze and running Latter Part the wind 30 ends this day
Oct 26th the Sun Observed
