

Remarks on Board Ship Horning W. North Master Nov 1838

Sunday Commences with moderate trades from E & S
Nov the 18 Starting by Wall sail set hant a new main sail.
N 40 and Thirzard the brig in sight in stern
Middle Part strong South the latter light tender pleasant
weather, Lat 10.20 North Long 22.40

Monday Commences with light trades stirring South by compass
Nov the 19 all sail set Middle and latter Part light trades
N 41 all hands employed in various jobs of ship duty
sooner this 24 hours, Lat 8.12 N. Long 23.10

Tuesday Commences with light air and hanting at 5 PM
Nov the 20 inclined to be calm, and overcast Middle Part
N 42 light air latter the same employed in fitting the
rigging sooner this 24 hours, Lat 6.50 North Long

Wednesday Light air from the S & am pleasant with
Nov the 21 hands employed in fitting the rigging and
N 43 various jobs of ship duty latter Part light
air at 6 PM saw a ship standing to the S & E
sooner this day, Lat 5.52 North Long

Thursday Commences with light breeze from the S & E
Nov the 22 stirring by the wind to the Southward all
N 44 hands employed in various jobs of ship duty
at 5 PM appeared a heavy squall with rain afterwards
fine weather, Lat 4.40 Long

Friday Commences with light breeze and fine weather
Nov the 23 hant up at 1 PM all hands employed in ship duty
N 45 saw a school of black fish Middle and latter Part
fresh breeze and squally from the S & E attended with
rain sooner this 24 hours, Long 24.30 Lat 2.45 N

Bound to the Pacific Ocean & Whaling 1838

Saturday Commences with fresh breeze from the S and East stirring
Nov the 24 by the wind to the South employed in ship duty
N 46 Middle Part squally attended with rain, latter Part
fresh breeze from the S & E all hands employed in
ship duty sooner this 24 hours Lat 2.10 N, Long

Sunday Commences with strong S & E trade stirring by the
Nov the 25 wind to the S & W Middle and latter Part the
N 47 same at 8 PM saw a brig standing to the N & W
all sail, Lat 10.2 miles South, Long 25.40

Monday First Part this 24 hours fresh breeze hant up S & W
Nov the 26 all sail set for the fore and main masts Middle and
N 48 latter Part strong S & E trade stirring by the wind to the
Southward all hands employed in ship duty, Lat 2.15 South

Tuesday Commences with strong trade at 6 PM took in the
Nov the 27 flying jib latter Part the same at 5 PM set the
N 49 fly jib saw a ship standing to the Southward all hands
employed in ship duty Lat 5.20 Long 26.40

Wednesday First Part this 24 hours trade hant up S & W
Nov the 28 the ship in sight Middle and latter Part
N 50 the same no sail in sight all hands employed in
various jobs of usual ship duty sooner, Lat 8.27 South

Thursday Commences with pleasant breeze from S & E stirring
Nov the 29 at 6 PM set the top masts Middle Part
N 51 set the top masts and top gallants stirring sail
set in the wind at East set the lower stirring
sail, Lat 11.09 South Long
