Sunday
Jan the 25
N 108 light wind from S W the boat ashore a number
men in the harbor at 8 the boat came off
made sail, stood on to sea with all sail set. Wind
Port calm. Latter light air from S E steering S W 2
sail in sight, Lat

Saturday
Jan the 26
N 109 light Port light air and calm. Wind and
Latter Port fine breeze. Steered S W steering S W 2
saw fin backs Lat Long

Sunday
Jan the 27
N 109 commences with light air and steering S W 2
saw fin backs Middle and Latter Port light air
and calm the front south steering S W 2, Lat 29.09

Monday
Jan the 28
N 110 First Port commences with light air from
South steering S W 2 Wind Port calm
Latter Port light air from S E, Lat

Tuesday
Jan the 28
N 111 First Port light air and calm, Employed
in painting boats and various jobs of
ship. Middle Port calm Latter
Port light air from East nothing remarkable
seen, Lat Long

Wednesday
Jan the 29
N 112 First Port light air from South but
the cleared boat placed ashore to catch on
the channel. Wind and Latter Port fine
breeze from S E steering S W 2 Employed in blacking
the boat saw black fish and porpoise, Lat 26.29

Thursday
Jan the 30
N 113 commences with fine wind and pleasant
weather steering to the West things seen a
big steering to the Eastward Wind and Latter
Port light air and pleasant the open boat in
sight, employed in tarring and cutting the fore rigging
Lat 24.54

On a Whaling Voyage in the Pacific

Sunday First Port this 24 hours pleasant weather and light
Jan the 31 wind from the South steering S W 2 Port
N 114 Calm Latter light air from South to East steering
S W 2, No wind, No wind here in sight, employed in tarring
and cutting rigging, Lat 23.30 Long 70.50

Saturday
Jan the 1
N 115 First Port light air and pleasant land
in sight, steering S W 2, Employed on the
rigging saw fin backs Middle Port light air
Latter light air from the South steering S W 2
nothing remarkable seen Lat 22.42

Sunday
Jan the 2
N 116 First Port light air and from the South
steering S W 2 the land in sight Middle and
Latter Port light air from East to South
steering S, saw a sail in the distance, Lat 20.16

Monday
Jan the 3
N 117 commences with light wind and pleasant weather
steering the land in sight Middle and Latter
Port light air, running down in shore the port of
Arica in sight land the channel, so end this day

Tuesday
Jan the 4
N 118 This day the weather fine and pleasant at 2 Port
came to anchor in the roadstead of Arica Latter
Port employed in getting off water and painting
4 vessels at anchor,

Wednesday
Jan the 5
N 119 This day fine weather steering water and
painting Latter Port the same the starboard
watch on shore and liberty

Thursday
Jan the 6
N 120 This day clear the starboard watch on liberty
the other employed in various jobs of ship
Lat 19.20
