Feb the 21 S.E. steering West. saw black fish and porpoise.
N 135 Middle and Latter Part light rain and calm
baffling round the compass showers of rain
at intervals, No Ob this day

Saturday First Part the wind light and variable
Feb the 22 Cloudy sea breeze W. Middle Part calm
N 136 Latter Part squalls of rain the wind varying
round the compass, Feb 4. 41, Long 89. 20 East

Sunday First Part this 24 hours light wind from the
Feb the 23 South steering to the Westward, Clear and
N 137 weather Middle and Latter Part the same
saw a number of shoals of black fish, Feb 4. 22 South

Monday Commenced with light wind and clear
Feb the 25 weather steering to the Westward, Middle and
N 138 Latter Part the same, Feb 4. 05,

Tuesday First Part this 24 hours light wind
Feb the 26 and baffling Middle and Latter Part
N 139 Part fresh wind from the South
steering W by S, saw porpoise etc.

Wednesday Commenced with fine wind from
Feb the 27 the South steering to the West
N 140 Middle and Latter Part the same
Feb 4. 30 South, Long

Thursday First Part this day fresh trade at 6 AM
Feb the 28 saw whales lowered being lost. Did not
N 140 strike. Latter Part fresh trade at 7 AM
saw whales lowered and shared the whale
porever the boat did not strike
Feb 4. 50 Long

Feb the 4 seen remarkable Middle Part Latter Part
N 144 steering from S.E. steering W by S, Feb 5. 18

Tuesday Commenced with fresh trade steering to the
Feb the 5 weather and Latter Part the same nothing
N 145 seen remarkable Feb Long

Wednesday Commenced with fresh trade with squalls
Feb the 6 rain at 6 AM shower and said steering W by S
N 146 Latter Part much the same where said
steering W by S Feb 3. 04 South

Thursday First Part moderate trade steering W by W
Feb the 7 Middle Part the wind light Latter Part light
N 147 wind and calm, Feb 2. 33 Long 113. 36

Friday First Part light wind and cloudy steering
Feb the 8 to the S and W Latter Part fresh trade
N 148 weather saw porpoise
Feb 7. 15 Long 114 38
