

Remarks on Board off the Bonin

Thursday Commenced with light air and pleasant
Sun the 20 weather began to boil Middle and latter
N^o 251 Part calm at 10 AM finished boiling 30th

Friday Light air and pleasant
Sun the 21 a sail coming off the land latter Part a
N^o 252 fine breeze at 30 AM lay off on the West
side of the North Island getting off potatoes

Saturday This 24 hours fine weather at 4 PM stopped
Sun the 22 out by the wind to the Southward the
N^o 253 Ohio in sight. With Part haul to the land
latter Part the same

Sunday This 24 hours commenced with fine weather
Sun the 23 at 2 PM spoke the Ohio stood off at 11 the wind
N^o 254 N^o at 6 PM pulled off shore to the Eastward of
South Island latter Part saw whales lowered
and got one but him in

Monday First Part fine weather began to boil
Sun the 24 the Ohio in sight. Latter Part the same
N^o 255 finished boiling the wind light

Tuesday First Part this 24 hours light wind
Sun the 25 wind and pleasant, off the East Part of
N^o 256 North Island and latter Part the same
at 11 AM saw whales lowered and killed

Wednesday
Sun the 26 First Part this 24 hours clearing
N^o 257 whales did not get a whale struck one
the snow broke the Ohio got one latter Part
at 11 AM wind ran down off North
Island sent a boat in for hogs

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Thursday First Part this 24 hours fresh breeze
Sun the 27 the boat came off stood out by the
N^o 258 wind to the S E in sight
at 10 o'clock to the Northward

Friday First Part commenced with light
Sun the 28 wind and pleasant at 6 PM the North
N^o 259 rocks bearing to the Eastward of us
the wind to the Eastward made to the
Northward latter Part employed in stowing
down bil saw five backs

Saturday commenced with fine weather the wind
Sun the 29 to the Eastward stowing to the Northward
N^o 260 finished stowing bil at 6 PM shortened sail
latter Part at 5 AM made sail

Sunday Fine weather the wind to the Eastward stowing
Sun the 30 to the S W at 3 PM saw the rock called the Horn
N^o 261 peak at 4 PM a shoal of whale lowered and
got & took him along side latter Part
but him in began to boil Lat. 29.20, Long 149.30 E

Monday Fine weather light air inclined to be calm
Sun the 31 boiling the whale latter Part at 6 PM a
N^o 262 Young Man by the name of Straggle
Hill was set a washing the hulls over out
side lost his hold up and fell overboard & went
over immediately lowered but found too late
to render him any assistance he got the merr
more to rise he was a native of Ireland born in
Dublin aged about 17 years
Lat. 29. 21 North Long 149. 38 East.
