Tuesday First Part this 24 hours light wind
July the 2^d and pleasant weather steering to the
N 263 Westward Observe rocks in sight
the wind S E steering to the N. E. Latter
Part fine weather, Lat. 30.00 Long 141.27 8

Wednesday Commenced with fine weather at 10 Observed
July the 3^d a ship steering to the S E at 6 spoke the
N 264 J Palmer of London, 23 months out 16.50 lb Latter
Part several employed in stowing Oil Lat.

Thursday First Part this 24 hours light squally rain
July the 4^d finished stowing Oil the Palmer in comp-
N 265 stowed by the wind to the Eastward
the wind to the Southward Latter the same
Lat. 30.29

Friday Light wind and pleasant the wind to the South
July the 5^d and West Latter the same nothing in
N 266 sight but a whale ship, Lat 30.47 Long 140.58

Saturday Light wind and pleasant at 5 P.M. spoke
July the 6^d the Hancock another ship in sight a
N 267 heard the wind to the Ohio West and Latter
Part steering by the wind to the S W the
wind W N W saw a plenty of squid

Sunday Light wind and weather at 4 P.M. saw whales
July the 7^d however did not strike the whales see the ship
N 268 the very light from W N W Latter Part saw
them again yet 2 40 lb each

Monday First Part Calm but in the whale began to
July the 8^d blow West and Latter Part light breeze the
N 269 Westward boiling 2 ships in sight

July the 9^d finished boiling at 8 saw whales got on
N 270 a ship in sight spoke the N. Scott

Wednesday Light wind and pleasant Latter Part in
July the 10^d the whale began to boil Lat. 29.30 Long 139.40 8
N 271

Thursday This 24 hours fine weather finished boiling
July the 11^d Latter Part breaking out the fore hatch way
to stow Oil Lat. Long
N 272

Friday Commenced with light wind from the
July the 12^d N 273 W steering Oil forward Latter Part
finished stowing Lat. Long

Saturday Fine weather the wind light and variable
July the 13^d spoke the Ohio Latter Part saw whales
N 274 however and blow the whale very quick

Sunday First Part light wind and pleasant some
July the 14^d small and struck 3 whales took them a long
N 275 swim and Latter Part but the others

Monday This 24 hours fine weather at 4 P.M. began
July the 15^d N 276 commenced boiling Latter the same

Tuesday First Part fine wind and weather at
July the 16^d N 277 10 P.M. finished boiling Latter Part
the water heated to the S W the wind S by S
141.25

Wednesday This 24 hours fine wind and weather began to
July the 17^d N 278 the S W very squally Latter Part stowed
down Oil in the fore hold
Lat. 28.45 6
