

Remarks on board Ship *Albatross* in the

Wednesday commences with fine wind and
July the 31 weather staying to the Eastward
N 292 at 6 AM began to get the wind to the
Northward commencing steering
bit in the Northward. Latter Part saw
a large whale lowered and lost the rear of
the whale. Lat. 31.34 Long

Thursday
July the 1st Start Part this 24 hours fresh wind from
N 293 the West finished steering bit at 6 AM hauled
the head down which hauled to the Southward
West. Latter Part saw a school of whales
lowered did not strike lat. Long

Friday
July the 2nd This 24 hours commences with fresh breeze
from the S at 6 AM shortened sail.
N 294 head to the Southward Latter Part heavy
weather, Lat 31.36 Long 142.44 East

Saturday
July the 3rd Commences with light wind steady
at a strong breeze setting to the West
N 295 the wind to the Westward Latter Part
saw a whale lowered and got a tooth
him a long side, Lat 31.08 Long 143.42

Sunday
July the 4th Commences with fine weather
but in the whale at 4 AM hauled
N 296 to the S at 6 AM the wind blowing
Latter Part at 9 AM saw a school of
whales lowered the whales and the Boats
and went off Lat 30.58 Long 143.27

July the 5th looking Northward Latter Part the
N 297 Lat 31.35
Tuesday light wind and pleasant weather
July the 6th saw a school of whales lowered and
N 298 got a tooth him a long side but

commenced looking Lat. Long

Wednesday
August 7th Start Part fresh breeze from the NE
July the 7th at 3 PM saw a whale lowered and got a tooth
N 299 them along side, Lat. Part but the whale
Lat. Long

Thursday
August 8th Fine weather began to boil Middle and
Latter Part boiling the wind shifted
N 300 from the Westward Lat 30.46 Long 143.59

Friday
August 9th light wind and pleasant weather boiling
July the 9th saw a blackfish Middle Part and Latter Part
N 301 same finished looking the fore and Mizzen
top sails fished Lat. Long

Saturday
August 10th Start Part fine weather began to
July the 10th stay bit in the whale at 4 AM saw
N 302 Latter strong wind and squally
steering bit Lat. Long

Sunday
August 11th Commences with strong wind from the
July the 11th S at 6 AM the wind bit at 6 AM saw 2 sperm
N 303 whales Latter Part the ship goes slow hauled
to the S Latter Part finished steering
