 N 308 better success latter Part saw a
 school of small whales lowered and
 got 1 took him along side began
 stowing him in the M. hold

Saturday Light wind from the Westward
 Aug the 17 finished stowing part in the whale
 N 309 began to hoist Mist and latter the
 same Lat. 31.20 Long 142.51

Sunday Light wind finished hoisting whaler
 Aug the 18 of the whaler latter Part light
 N 310 air and calm Lat. Long

Long from 143 to 140 Lat 31 to 29 North
