Sailed Port then 24 hours from Port
Sept 16 wind from NW stirring by the wind
N 338 together North and East a high swell on
Middle Part the same latter Part
thick and hazy the wind light from
N 340 took ship head up N 340

Tuesday commences with thick and rain
Sept 17 weather the wind light from N 340
N 339 up NW a high swell on Middle Part
the same latter Part commences with strong
wind and squalls took ship head up N 340
at 9 AM blowing squalls in squalls of rain
from the south the ship under present
sail N 340 this day

Wednesday commences with strong wind
Sept 18 squalls of rain a high swell
N 340 from NW stirring by the wind
the squalls and squalls sail at
Middle Part the wind light latter Part
N 340 stirring by the wind the ship under
single reefed sails, Lat 29 57 Long 126 26

Thursday first Part then 24 hours strong wind
Sept 19 and squalls from N 340 stirring by the wind
N 341 under present sail Middle Part
heavy Moderate latter Part rain all
sail the wind light stirring by the wind
N 341 blowing away the flying jib boom thick
and hazy weather
N 341 this day

N 342 together North and East a high swell on
Middle Part the same latter Part
thick and hazy the wind light from
N 340 took ship head up N 340

sail N 340 this day

Saturday commences with light wind from the N
Sept 21 eastward stirring by the wind
N 343 together North and East a high swell on
Middle Part the same latter Part
thick and hazy the wind light from
N 340 took ship head up N 340
at 9 AM blowing squalls in squalls of rain
from the south the ship under present
sail N 340 this day

Sunday first Part then 24 hours from Port
Sept 22 stirring by the wind the ship under
N 344 together North and East a high swell on
Middle Part the same latter Part
thick and hazy the wind light from
N 340 took ship head up N 340
at 9 AM blowing squalls in squalls of rain
from the south the ship under present
sail N 340 this day
