Friday First Part light wind from N.E. at 1 P.M.
 In the 5th saw a shoal of small whales hauled up
 N^o 419 and got 2 took them along side but then
 in Middle Part lay aback hauled to the
 N.E. latter Part heavy incline to rain

Saturday commences with falling wind and
 In the 6th rainy weather a ship in sight
 N^o 420 latter Part rainy and calm finished boiling
 Lat. 2.08 S Long 177.50 East

Sunday In the 7th First Part strong wind and cloudy
 N^o 421 from N.E. at 4 P.M. saw whales hauled
 and got 4 took them along side a ship
 in sight latter Part the same but in
 the whole began to lull saw whales hauled
 got strike spoke the Whet of London

Monday commences with moderate breeze
 In the 8th the Whet in company at 4 P.M.
 N^o 422 finished boiling Middle and latter
 Part the wind light Lat. 2.16 S

Monday commences with a light breeze from
 In the 14th the Northward at sunset saw a
 N^o 429 shoal of whale too late to haul
 latter Part light air saw whales did not start
 Lat. Long
