587 fine bark at 3 o'clock continued sail. Latter
Part fresh wind freshened & employed in steering
Sib forward, finished, Lark - Long

11.10.17. Part moderate wind from N.E.
 11.11.17. stormy by the wind to the S.E. saw
 11.3.22. fin backs. Greenish herons. Billies
 lined. Herons and others. Latter Part
